## KATA PENGANTAR

Laporan Statistik Upah Pekerja (Sektor Formal) Suku Tahunan diterbitkan oleh Jabatan Perangkaan Malaysia (DOSM) menggunakan sumber data pentadbiran yang diperoleh daripada agensi berkaitan seperti Kumpulan Wang Simpanan Pekerja (KWSP) dan Pertubuhan Keselamatan Sosial (PERKESO). Inisiatif menerbitkan Laporan Statistik Upah Pekerja (Sektor Formal) Suku Tahunan ini adalah bagi memenuhi permintaan yang semakin meningkat bagi statistik upah yang komprehensif dengan kekerapan yang tinggi. Laporan ini menyediakan statistik upah pekerja warganegara Malaysia mengikut ciri-ciri demografi dan sosioekonomi antaranya jantina, etnik, kumpulan umur, aktiviti ekonomi dan negeri.

Statistik upah pekerja merupakan maklumat penting yang digunakan sebagai input untuk menganalisis pasaran buruh, menggubal dasar serta merancang, melaksana dan memantau program berkaitan pembangunan sumber manusia ke arah pengukuran pasaran buruh negara. Statistik ini juga menjadi rujukan penting kepada penyelidik, ahli ekonomi, ahli akademik, pihak swasta dan individu dalam kajian berkaitan guna tenaga, gaji & upah dan pasaran buruh.

Penerbitan ini mengandungi tiga bahagian. Bahagian pertama membentangkan ringkasan penemuan bagi bilangan pekerja sektor formal, median upah dan taburan upah. Bahagian kedua memaparkan jadual statistik. Aspek teknikal seperti kaedah pengumpulan data, skop & liputan dan konsep & definisi disediakan di bahagian terakhir bagi memudahkan pengguna memahami statistik yang diterbitkan.

The initiative to publish this Quarterly Employee Wages Statistics (Formal Sector) Report is to meet the escalating demand for comprehensive wage statistics with high frequency. This report provides wage statistics for Malaysian citizens according to demographic and socioeconomic characteristics encompassing sex, ethnic, age groups, economic activities and state.

Employee wages statistics serves as a crucial source of information which were used as input for labour market analysis, policy formulation as well as planning, implementing and monitoring programmes related to human resource development towards strengthening the national labour market. These statistics also serve as a vital reference for researchers, economists, academicians, private sector and individuals in research related to employment, wages and the labour market.

This publication contains three parts. The first part presents a summary of findings of the number of formal sector employees, median wage and wage distribution. 


Bilangan pekerja formal warganegara pada **Jun 2023** adalah seramai **6,599.8** ribu orang dengan median upah bulanan **RM2,600**.


ETNIK

Kumpulan umur **45 hingga 49 tahun** mencatatkan median upah bulanan tertinggi iaitu **RM3,500** pada Jun 2023.



## KONSEP & DEFINISI




The number of citizen formal employees in June 2023 was 6,599.8 thousand persons with median monthly wages of RM2,600.

### ETHNIC


Chinese formal employees recorded the highest median monthly wages in June 2023 (RM4,000).



### AGE GROUP


The age group of 45 to 49 years posted the highest median monthly wages of RM3,500 in June 2023.

Median Monthly Wages (RM)




### ECONOMIC ACTIVITY

### CONCEPT & DEFINITION

**Wages** refer to all remuneration paid to employees, including bonuses, commissions and allowances, during the reference period.

The **Median** refers to the middle observation in a set of data arranged in a sequence. The median wage is used to give a more accurate picture of the "average wage", as the determination of the median is not affected by extreme values.

# RINGKASAN PENEMUAN


## 1. PENGENALAN

Penerbitan Statistik Upah Pekerja (Sektor Formal) Suku Tahunan adalah sebahagian daripada inisiatif Jabatan Perangkaan Malaysia untuk menyediakan statistik upah yang lebih komprehensif, terperinci dan bertepatan masa bagi memenuhi permintaan pengguna yang semakin meningkat. Laporan ini adalah berdasarkan data pentadbiran dari pelbagai agensi dan memberi tumpuan kepada pekerja warganegara dalam sektor formal swasta Malaysia. Upah yang dianggarkan dalam penerbitan ini merujuk kepada semua ganjaran kewangan meliputi bonus, komisen, dan elaun yang dibayar kepada pekerja untuk pekerjaan mereka dalam tempoh rujukan. Statistik yang dikeluarkan ini boleh digunakan sebagai input untuk menganalisis kedudukan pasaran buruh, menggubal dasar serta merancang, melaksana dan memantau program berkaitan Pembangunan sumber manusia ke arah pengukuran pasaran buruh negara.

## 2. KEDUDUKAN UPAH PEKERJA FORMAL MALAYSIA

Ketika ekonomi Malaysia mengalami peningkatan sederhana pada suku tahun kedua 2023, pasaran buruh negara terus berkembang dalam tempoh yang sama. Statistik menunjukkan terdapat 16.15 juta orang bekerja yang merangkumi pekerja bergaji di kedua sektor awam dan swasta, majikan, bekerja sendiri dan pekerja keluarga tanpa gaji (**Paparan 1**). Bilangan penduduk bekerja meningkat 0.5 peratus pada suku tahun kedua 2023 berbanding suku sebelumnya (ST1 2023: 16.06 juta orang).

**Paparan 1: Kerangka Analisis Gaji & Upah Bulanan, ST2 2023**



## RINGKASAN PENEMUAN

Berdasarkan data pentadbiran yang direkodkan, bilangan pekerja formal pada Jun 2023 ialah 6.60 juta orang (Mei 2023: 6.58 juta orang; April 2023: 6.60 juta orang). Ini menunjukkan peningkatan 1.6 peratus (Mei 2023: 2.3%; April 2023: 2.7%) berbanding bulan yang sama pada tahun sebelumnya (Jun 2022: 6.50 juta orang). Bilangan ini meliputi hampir dua pertiga (64.3%) daripada keseluruhan bilangan pekerja bergaji warganegara dalam sektor formal. Median upah bulanan bagi pekerja formal warganegara pada Jun 2023 ialah RM2,600 (Mei 2023: RM2,582; April 2023: RM2,664), mencatatkan pertumbuhan 4.9 peratus tahun ke tahun (Mei 2023: 5.6%; April 2023: 6.5%). ### 3. BILANGAN PEKERJA FORMAL DAN MEDIAN UPAH BULANAN MENGIKUT JANTINA


Pekerja formal lelaki merangkumi 55.5 peratus daripada keseluruhan pekerja formal pada Jun 2023, bersamaan dengan 3.66 juta orang (Mei 2023: 3.66 juta orang; April 2023: 3.67 juta orang). Kumpulan ini mencatatkan median upah bulanan sebanyak RM2,645 pada Jun 2023 yang meningkat 5.8 peratus berbanding tahun sebelumnya (Jun 2022: RM2,500). Pertumbuhan tahun ke tahun median upah bulanan bagi April dan Mei 2023 masing-masing ialah 8.0 peratus dan 4.0 peratus.

Sementara itu, pekerja formal perempuan meliputi 44.5 peratus daripada jumlah keseluruhan, berjumlah 2.94 juta orang. Median upah bulanan perempuan pekerja formal bagi April, Mei dan Jun 2023 masing-masing ialah RM2,600, RM2,500 dan RM2,527 dengan kadar peningkatan 7.3 peratus, 4.2 peratus dan 5.3 peratus tahun ke tahun.

Melihat kepada perbandingan antara jantina, pekerja formal lelaki menerima median upah bulanan yang lebih tinggi daripada perempuan dalam semua bulan bagi suku tahun kedua 2023. Pekerja formal lelaki (RM2,645) memperoleh median upah bulanan hampir 4.7 peratus lebih tinggi daripada pekerja formal perempuan (RM2,527) pada Jun 2023. (**Paparan 2**)

### Paparan 2: Bilangan Pekerja Formal dan Median Upah Bulanan Mengikut Jantina, April - Jun 2023




#### 4. BILANGAN PEKERJA FORMAL DAN MEDIAN UPAH BULANAN MENGIKUT ETNIK

Median upah bulanan bagi kesemua etnik mencatatkan peningkatan tahun ke tahun bagi ketiga-tiga bulan pada suku tahun kedua 2023. Pada Jun 2023, India mencatatkan peningkatan tahun ke tahun median upah bulanan tertinggi sebanyak 7.4 peratus kepada RM2,500, meningkat daripada RM2,327 pada Jun 2022 (Mei 2023: RM2,500; April: RM2,500). Peratusan pekerja formal etnik India mencapai 7.9 peratus, atau 0.52 juta orang (Mei 2023: 0.53 juta orang; April 2023: 0.53 juta orang).

Kumpulan etnik terbesar, Bumiputera, meliputi 61.6 peratus atau bersamaan 4.07 juta orang pekerja formal, mencatatkan peningkatan median upah bulanan kepada RM2,200 pada Jun 2023 (Mei 2023: RM2,182; April 2023: RM2,245), meningkat 6.6 peratus berbanding tahun sebelumnya (Mei 2023: 7.6%; April 2023: 8.8%). Pada masa yang sama, pekerja formal Cina yang mewakili 29.2 peratus atau bersamaan 1.93 juta orang mencatatkan median upah bulanan tertinggi, iaitu sebanyak RM4,000 dengan pertumbuhan 6.3 peratus pada Jun 2023. Pada bulan April dan Mei 2023, pekerja formal Cina mencatatkan median upah bulanan yang sama sebanyak RM4,000 dengan masing-masing mengalami peningkatan tahun ke tahun yang sama sebanyak 8.1 peratus. ## 5. BILANGAN PEKERJA FORMAL DAN MEDIAN UPAH BULANAN MENGIKUT KUMPULAN UMUR

Perincian mengikut umur menunjukkan kumpulan umur yang mencatatkan median upah bulanan tertinggi pada Jun 2023 ialah kumpulan umur 45 hingga 49 tahun, menerima median upah bulanan sebanyak RM3,500. Kumpulan umur ini juga menerima median upah bulanan tertinggi pada April 2023 (RM3,582) dan Mei 2023 (RM3,482). Sebaliknya, kumpulan umur di bawah 20 tahun menerima median upah bulanan terendah sebanyak RM1,500 bagi ketiga-tiga bulan pada suku tahun kedua 2023.

Perbandingan median upah bulanan pada Jun 2023 dengan bulan yang sama pada tahun sebelumnya menunjukkan semua kumpulan umur mengalami peningkatan median upah bulanan kecuali bagi mereka yang berumur di bawah 20 tahun. Kumpulan umur 60 hingga 64 tahun menunjukkan peningkatan tahun ke tahun tertinggi pada Jun dan Mei 2023, masing-masing meningkat 11.7 peratus dan 11.0 peratus. Sementara itu, pada April 2023, kumpulan umur di bawah 20 tahun menikmati pertumbuhan tahun ke tahun tertinggi (25.0%), yang tertinggi untuk empat bulan berturut-turut semenjak Januari 2023. Walau bagaimanapun, median upah bulanan bagi kumpulan umur di bawah 20 tahun perlakan pada Mei 2023 (pertumbuhan tahun ke tahun: 5.5%) dan kekal pada Jun 2023 (pertumbuhan tahun ke tahun: 0.0%) disebabkan kesan asas implementasi kadar gaji minimum baharu RM1,500 pada 2022 telah mereda. ## 6. BILANGAN PEKERJA FORMAL DAN MEDIAN UPAH BULANAN MENGIKUT AKTIVITI EKONOMI


Daripada perspektif aktiviti ekonomi, kesemua sektor mencatatkan peningkatan median upah bulanan pada Jun 2023 kecuali sektor Pertanian. Sektor Pertanian, dengan komposisi 2.0 peratus daripada keseluruhan pekerja formal, berkurang sebanyak 0.9 peratus tahun ke tahun bagi merekodkan median upah bulanan sebanyak RM1,927 pada Jun 2023 (Mei 2023: RM1,964; April 2023: RM1,964). Pada masa yang sama, sektor Perlombongan dan pengkuarian, yang merangkumi 0.5 peratus daripada jumlah pekerja formal, mencatatkan median upah bulanan tertinggi iaitu RM5,200 pada Jun 2023 (Mei 2023: RM5,200; April 2023: RM5,400). Sektor ini mencatatkan pertumbuhan tahun ke tahun tertinggi bagi kesemua tiga bulan pada suku tahun kedua 2023 (Jun 2023: 15.0%; Mei 2023: 15.6%; April 2023: 13.3%).

Sementara itu, sektor Pembuatan dengan komposisi 18.3 peratus daripada jumlah pekerja formal mencatatkan peningkatan median upah bulanan sebanyak 7.6 peratus tahun ke tahun kepada RM2,464 pada Jun 2023 (Mei 2023: RM2,400; April 2023: RM2,500). Perincian kepada subsektor Pembuatan menunjukkan median upah bulanan tertinggi adalah bagi subsektor Minuman dan produk tembakau (RM2,982), diikuti Produk elektrik, elektronik dan optikal (RM2,567). Berdasarkan kenaikan tahunan, median upah bulanan tertinggi dicatatkan oleh subsektor Produk kayu, perabot, keluaran kertas dan percetakan, iaitu meningkat 9.7 peratus kepada RM2,264 pada Jun 2023.

Pada masa yang sama, pekerja formal dalam sektor Pembinaan yang merangkumi 6.2 peratus daripada jumlah pekerja mencatatkan median upah bulanan sebanyak RM2,700 (Jun 2023), peningkatan sebanyak 2.1 peratus berbanding tahun sebelumnya. Sementara itu, sektor Perkhidmatan (sumbangan: 67.2%) mengalami kenaikan 4.0 peratus tahun ke tahun median upah bulanan kepada RM2,600 pada Jun 2023 (Mei 2023: RM2,600; April 2023: RM2,682). Dua subsektor yang mencatatkan median upah bulanan tertinggi ialah Kewangan dan insurans sebanyak RM5,700, diikuti oleh Maklumat dan komunikasi (RM4,964). Sementara itu, subsektor Makanan & minuman dan penginapan merekodkan median upah bulanan terendah pada RM1,800. (**Paparan 5**)

## 7. BILANGAN PEKERJA FORMAL DAN MEDIAN UPAH BULANAN MENGIKUT NEGERI

Semua negeri mencatatkan pertumbuhan positif tahun ke tahun dari segi median upah bulanan. Tiga negeri yang merekodkan median upah bulanan yang lebih tinggi berbanding median upah bulanan nasional pada Jun 2023 adalah W.P. Kuala Lumpur pada RM3,822, Selangor (RM2,945) dan Pulau Pinang (RM2,645). Walau bagaimanapun, Kelantan, Perlis dan Sabah merupakan negeri yang mencatatkan median upah bulanan terendah dengan median upah masing-masing sebanyak RM1,600, RM1,600 dan RM1,800. Merujuk kepada sumbangan bilangan pekerja, tiga negeri utama yang mencatatkan bilangan pekerja formal tertinggi setakat Jun 2023 adalah Selangor (1.87 juta orang; sumbangan: 28.4%), W.P. Kuala Lumpur (1.32 juta orang; sumbangan: 20.1%), dan Johor (0.70 juta orang; sumbangan: 10.6%). (**Paparan 6**)


### 8. TABURAN MEDIAN UPAH BULANAN PEKERJA FORMAL

Analisis taburan upah menunjukkan 34.7 peratus pekerja formal di Malaysia berpendapatan di bawah RM2,000 pada Jun 2023. Peratusan ini berkurangan daripada 38.3 peratus yang dicatatkan pada tahun sebelumnya, memberi isyarat bahawa sesetengah pekerja telah memperoleh skala gaji yang lebih baik. Pada masa sama, kira-kira 7.9 peratus pekerja formal memperoleh upah bulanan tertinggi (RM10,000 ke atas) pada Jun 2023.

Sementara itu, analisis persentil menunjukkan bahawa persentil ke-10 bagi pekerja formal memperoleh upah bersamaan atau kurang daripada RM1,500 sebulan iaitu 17.0 peratus lebih tinggi daripada bulan yang sama tahun sebelumnya (RM1,282). Pada persentil ke-90, pekerja formal Malaysia memperoleh sekurang-kurangnya RM8,500 sebulan dengan mencatatkan peningkatan 6.3 peratus berbanding Jun 2022. Nisbah upah antara kumpulan penerima upah tertinggi (persentil ke-90) dan kumpulan penerima upah terendah (persentil ke-10) menggambarkan penerima upah di kelas tertinggi menerima lebih daripada lima kali ganda upah berbanding penerima upah di kelas yang terendah. Perantaian ke hadapan, Jabatan Perangkaan Malaysia (DOSM) berlitzam untuk terus menambah baik data-data ini dalam masa terdekat. Di samping itu, beberapa sumber data lain seperti data emolumen penjawat awam, maklumat pendapatan pembayar cukai, dan set data lain yang berkaitan, sedang dipertimbangkan untuk diliputi agar statistik ini menjadi lebih komprehensif dan inklusif.

Selain itu, melalui pengintegrasian dengan data pentadbiran lain, DOSM akan menghasilkan statistik gaji pekerja formal yang lebih dinamik merangkumi trend, pola, min, median dan taburan upah mengikut saiz pekerja yang lebih dinamik meliputi statistik bilangan dan upah pekerja formal mengikut saiz pertubuhan (PMKS & bukan PMKS), mengikut jenis intensif industri (intensif modal atau buruh), mengikut tahap kemahiran dan jenis pekerjaan pekerja, mengikut status syarikat seperti Syarikat Multi-Nasional (MNC) dan Pelaburan Langsung Asing (FDI), mengikut pemilikan pertubuhan syarikat, mengikut perniagaan berorientasikan eksport atau permintaan domestik, mengikut skala ekonomi perniagaan, mengikut usia perniagaan dan lain-lain.

Di samping itu, penambahaikan dari aspek metodologi penyusunan dan sumber data baharu dilaksanakan secara berterusan selaras dengan amalan terbaik Pejabat Statistik Negara (NSO) yang lain. Pada masa yang sama, aspek gaji dan upah daripada perspektif penawaran buruh diteliti menerusi Survei Gaji dan Upah yang telah dilaksanakan oleh DOSM sejak 2010. Survei yang menggunakan kaedah persampelan dan pendekatan sirumah ini menjadikan nanda aras kepada median dan median populasi penerima gaji & upah Malaysia.


## 1. INTRODUCTION

The Quarterly Employee Wages Statistics (Formal Sector) Publication is part of the Department of Statistics Malaysia's initiative to provide more comprehensive, granular and frequent wages statistics to meet increasing user demand. This report is based on administrative data from various agencies and primarily focuses on citizen employees in Malaysia's formal private sector. The wages estimated in this publication refers to all monetary payables including bonuses, commissions, and allowances paid to employees for the work done during the reference period. The statistics released can be used as input for analysing the labour market situation, formulating policies, as well as planning, implementing and monitoring programmes related to human resource development towards strengthening Malaysia's labour market.

## 2. WAGES SITUATION OF FORMAL EMPLOYEES IN MALAYSIA

Despite Malaysia's economy experienced a modest increase in the second quarter of 2023, the national labour market continues to expand during the same period. The statistic reveals that there were 16.15 million employed persons encompasses paid employees in both the public and private sectors, employers, self-employed and unpaid family workers (**Exhibit 1**). The number of employed persons increased 0.5 per cent from the previous quarter (Q1 2023: 16.06 million persons).

**Exhibit 1: Monthly Salaries & Wages Analysis Framework, Q2 2023**



## SUMMARY OF FINDINGS

Based on administrative records, the number of formal employees in June 2023, was 6.60 million persons (May 2023: 6.58 million persons; April 2023: 6.60 million persons). This represented a 1.6 per cent increase (May 2023: 2.3%; April 2023: 2.7%) compared to the same month in the previous year (June 2022: 6.50 million persons). This number accounted for nearly two-thirds (64.3%) of the total number of citizens paid employees who are paid in formal sector. The median monthly wages for formal citizen employees in June 2023 was RM2,600 (May 2023: RM2,582; April 2023: RM2,664), reflecting a 4.9 per cent year-on-year growth (May 2023: 5.6%; April 2023: 6.5%). (Chart 1).

### 3. NUMBER AND MEDIAN MONTHLY WAGES FOR FORMAL EMPLOYEES BY SEX


Male formal employees accounted for 55.5 per cent of all formal employees in June 2023 or equivalent to 3.66 million persons (May 2023: 3.66 million persons; April 2023: 3.67 million persons). This group recorded median monthly wages of RM2,645 in June 2023 which increased by 5.8 per cent compared to the same month of previous year (June 2022: RM2,500). The year-on-year growth of the median monthly wages for April and May 2023 were 8.0 per cent and 4.0 per cent, respectively.

Meanwhile, female formal employees accounted for 44.5 per cent of the total, amounting to 2.94 million persons. The median monthly wages of female formal employees for April, May and June 2023 were RM2,600, RM2,500, and RM2,527, with an increase rate of 7.3 per cent, 4.2 per cent and 5.3 per cent year-on-year, respectively.

Looking at the comparison between sex, male formal employees received higher median monthly wages than females in all months for the second quarter of 2023. Male formal employees (RM2,645) earned median monthly wages almost 4.7 per cent more than female formal employees (RM2,527) in June 2023. (Exhibit 2).

April - June 2023**




### 4. NUMBER AND MEDIAN MONTHLY WAGES FOR FORMAL EMPLOYEES BY ETHNIC

The median monthly wages of all ethnicities recorded year-on-year increases for all three months in the second quarter of 2023. In June 2023, Indian recorded the highest year-on-year growth increase in median monthly wages of 7.4 per cent to RM2,500, up from RM2,327 in June 2022 (May 2023: RM2,500; April: RM2,500). The proportion of formal employees of Indian ethnicity formal employees reached 7.9 per cent, or 0.52 million persons (May 2023: 0.53 million persons; April 2023: 0.53 million persons).

The largest ethnic group, Bumiputera, which consists of 61.6 per cent or equivalent to 4.07 million persons, registered an increase in median monthly wages to RM2,200 in June 2023 (May 2023: RM2,182; April 2023: RM2,245), an increase of 6.6 per cent as compared to the previous year (May 2023: 7.6%; April 2023: 8.8%). At the same time, Chinese formal employees, who represent 29.2 per cent or equivalent to 1.93 million persons, recorded the highest median monthly wages of RM4,000 with a growth of 6.3 per cent in June 2023. In April and May 2023, Chinese formal employees recorded the median monthly wages the same amount of RM4,000 with each experiencing a year-on-year increase of 8.1 per cent. (**Exhibit 3**)

### 5. NUMBER AND MEDIAN MONTHLY WAGES FOR FORMAL EMPLOYEES BY AGE GROUP

Delving by the age group indicates the group recorded the highest median monthly wages in June 2023 was the age group of 45 to 49 years, which received median monthly wages of RM3,500. This age group also received the highest median monthly wages in April 2023 (RM3,582) and May 2023 (RM3,482). On the other hand, age group below 20 years old received the lowest median monthly wages of RM1,500 for all three months in the second quarter of 2023.

Comparing of the median monthly wages in June 2023 with the same month in the previous year, showed that all age groups experienced an increase in the median monthly wages, except for those below 20 years. The age group 60 to 64 years demonstrates the highest year-on-year increases in June and May 2023, which increased 11.7 per cent and 11.0 per cent, respectively. Meanwhile, in April 2023, the age group below 20 years enjoyed the highest year-on-year growth (25.0%), the highest for four consecutive months since January 2023. However, median wages for the group below 20 years was slowed in May 2023 (year-on-year growth: 5.5%) and stagnant in June 2023 (year-on-year growth: 0.0%) due to the base effect of the implementation of the new minimum wage rate of RM1,500 in 2022 having subsided. (**Exhibit 4**)

### 6. NUMBER AND MEDIAN MONTHLY WAGES FOR FORMAL EMPLOYEES BY ECONOMIC ACTIVITY


From the perspective of economic activity, all sectors recorded an increase in median monthly wages in June 2023 except the Agriculture sector. The Agriculture sector, with a composition of 2.0 per cent of the total formal employees, decreased by 0.9 per cent year-on-year to record a median monthly wages of RM1,927 in June 2023 (May 2023: RM1,964; April 2023: RM1,964). In the meantime, the Mining and quarrying sector, which comprises 0.5 per cent of the total formal employees, recorded the highest median monthly wages at RM5,200 in June 2023 (May 2023: RM5,200; April 2023: RM5,400). This sector posted the highest year-on-year growth for all three months of the second quarter of 2023 (June 2023: 15.0%; May 2023: 15.6%; April 2023: 13.3%).

Meanwhile, the Manufacturing sector with a composition of 18.3 per cent of the total formal employees, recorded an increase in median monthly wages of 7.6 per cent year-on-year to RM2,464 in June 2023 (May 2023: RM2,400; April 2023: RM2,500). Delving deeper into Manufacturing sub-sectors, it was shown that the highest median monthly wages were in the Beverage and tobacco products (RM2,982), followed by Electrical, electronic and optical products (RM2,567). In terms of annual increases, the highest median monthly wages were recorded by Wood products, furniture, paper products and printing, which increased by 9.7 per cent to RM2,264 in June 2023.

In the meantime, formal employees in the Construction sector, comprising 6.2 per cent of the total employees, have registered median monthly wages of RM2,700, an increase of 2.1 per cent from the same month of the previous year. Meanwhile, the Services sector (share: 67.2%) experienced an increase of 4.0 per cent year-on-year in median monthly wages to RM2,600 in June 2023 (May 2023: RM2,600; April 2023: RM2,682). The two sub-sectors that recorded the highest median monthly wages were Finance and insurance at RM5,700, followed by Information and communication (RM4,964). Meanwhile, Food & beverages and accommodation recorded the lowest median monthly wages at RM1,800. (**Exhibit 5**)

### 7. NUMBER AND MEDIAN MONTHLY WAGES FOR FORMAL EMPLOYEES BY STATE

All states indicated positive year-on-year growth in terms of the median monthly wages. Three states with greater median monthly wages than the national median monthly wages in June 2023 were W.P. Kuala Lumpur at RM3,822, Selangor (RM2,945) and Pulau Pinang (RM2,645). However, Kelantan, Perlis, and Sabah registered the lowest median monthly wages during the same month, with respective wages of RM1,600, RM1,600, and RM1,800. Referring to the contribution of the number of employees, the top three states that recorded the highest number of formal employees as of June 2023 were Selangor (1.87 million persons; share: 28.4%), W.P. Kuala Lumpur (1.32 million persons; share: 20.1%), and Johor (0.70 million persons; share: 10.6%). (**Exhibit 6**)


### 8. DISTRIBUTION OF MONTHLY WAGES FOR FORMAL EMPLOYEES

Analysis of the wage distribution showed that 34.7 per cent of Malaysian formal employees earned below RM2,000 in June 2023. This proportion decreased from 38.3 per cent recorded in the previous year, signalling that some employees reached a better wage scale. Concurrently, about 7.9 per cent of formal employees earned the highest monthly wages (RM10,000 and above) in June 2023.

Meanwhile, the percentile analysis indicates that the 10th percentile of formal employees earned wages equal to or less than RM1,500 per month which is 17.0 per cent higher than the same month of the previous year (RM1,282). At the 90th percentile, formal employees in Malaysia earned at least RM8,500 per month, which recorded an increase of 6.3 per cent from June 2022. The wage ratio between the highest wage earner group (90th percentile) and the lowest wage earner group (10th percentile) illustrates that the higher wage earner group received the wage more than five times compared to the lowest wage earner group. ## SUMMARY OF FINDINGS

### 9. MOVING FORWARD

*Looking ahead, the Department of Statistics Malaysia (DOSM) is committed to continue to improve these data in the immediate future. In addition, several types of other data sources, such as civil servant emolument data, taxpayer income information, and other relevant datasets, are being considered to be used in order for these statistics to become more comprehensive and inclusive.*

*Moreover, integrating data from various administrative sources will yield dynamic information on trends, patterns, minimum, median, and distribution of employees' wages by size of the employees, including statistics on the number and wages of formal employees categorized by organization size, distinguishing between Small and Medium Enterprises (SME) and Non-Small and Medium Enterprises (Non-SME). The data will also be categorized based on industry intensity (capital-intensive or labor-intensive), skill and occupation levels, company status (such as Multinational Companies - MNCs, Foreign Direct Investment - FDI), company ownership, business orientation (export-oriented or domestic demand-oriented), business economic scale, company establishment period, and other relevant factors.*

*Continuous improvement in methodology and the inclusion of new data sources are carried out in line with the practices of other National Statistical Offices (NSOs). Simultaneously, DOSM conducts the Salaries & Wages Survey, which uses sampling methods and household-based approaches. This survey serves as a benchmark for the minimum and median salaries and wages received by the population in Malaysia.*

# NOTA TEKNIKAL

## 1. PENGENALAN

Statistik Upah Pekerja disusun menggunakan data pentadbiran daripada pelbagai agensi bagi memantau prestasi gaji dan upah negara. Statistik yang dikeluarkan meliputi bilangan pekerja formal dan median upah bulanan. Nota teknikal ini menyediakan penerangan terperinci mengenai konsep, definisi dan metodologi yang digunakan dalam penyusunan statistik ini bagi membantu pengguna untuk lebih memahami berkaitan maklumat upah pekerja yang dikeluarkan.

## 2. KONSEP DAN DEFINISI

**Majikan** : Merujuk kepada entiti ekonomi yang bekerja sama ada melalui kontrak perkhidmatan atau latihan perantisan, dan dilaporkan melalui sistem pekerjaan yang sesuai.

**Pekerja Formal** : Merujuk kepada individu yang bekerja di bawah kontrak perkhidmatan atau latihan perantisan bermajikan dan menerima ganjaran untuk kerja yang diselesaikan. Pekerja formal tidak termasuk mereka yang tergolong di bawah pekerjaan bukan standard, termasuk individu bekerja sendiri, pekerja gig, pekerja akaun sendiri, pekerja keluarga tanpa gaji, dan sebagainya.

**Upah** : Merujuk kepada semua ganjaran dalam bentuk wang yang dibayar sepanjang tempoh rujukan kepada pekerja. Anggaran upah termasuk bonus, komisen, dan elaun mengikut definisi sumber data. Tidak termasuk caj perkhidmatan; bayaran kerja lebih masa; ganjaran; faedah persaraan; faedah pengurangan pekerja, pemberhentian atau penamatian; mana-mana elaun perjalanan atau nilai mana-mana konsesi perjalanan; atau mana-mana saraan atau bayaran lain sebagaimana yang dikecualikan oleh Menteri.

Upah tidak termasuk pendapatan dari perniagaan sendiri atau sumber lain.

**Aktiviti Ekonomi** : Klasifikasi aktiviti ekonomi merujuk kepada Piawaian Klasifikasi Industri Malaysia (MSIC) 2008 Ver.1.0 yang selaras dengan *International Standard Industrial Classification of All Economic Activities (ISIC), Rev. 4*. Pengelasan subsektor dan aktiviti ekonomi adalah seperti paparan di bawah, dengan perincian lapan (8) subsektor bagi sektor Pembuatan dan Perkhidmatan.

### **3. TEMPOH RUJUKAN**

Statistik ini berdasarkan kaedah akruan mengikut saranan Sistem Akaun Negara 2008 (SNA), yang mengambil kira bulan ketika kerja dilakukan tanpa mengira bilakah pembayaran dibuat atau diterima.

### **4. SKOP DAN LIPUTAN**

Pengeluaran statistik upah pekerja sektor formal adalah bersumberkan data pentadbiran yang meliputi data caruman wajib simpanan pekerja sektor swasta dan pekerja tidak berpencen di sektor awam serta data caruman insurans keselamatan sosial pekerja yang diperoleh daripada pelbagai agensi dengan tumpuan kepada pekerja warganegara dalam sektor formal di Malaysia. Data ini tidak meliputi orang yang bekerja berada di bawah pekerjaan bukan standard, termasuk pekerja akaun sendiri dan pekerja keluarga yang tidak dibayar.

### **5. SUMBER DATA**

Sumber data utama bagi penerbitan ini adalah daripada beberapa rekod pentadbiran yang dibekalkan oleh agensi berkaitan, seperti Kumpulan Wang Simpanan Pekerja (KWSP), Pertubuhan Keselamatan Sosial (PERKESO) dan lain-lain. *Malaysia Statistical Business Register* (MBSR) merupakan kerangka kerja pertubuhan dan perusahaan yang beroperasi di Malaysia turut digunakan sebagai asas penyusunan data. MBSR merangkumi Daftar Syarikat (ROC), Daftar Perniagaan (ROB) dan Perkongsian Liabiliti Terhad (LLP) yang berdaftar dengan Suruhanjaya Syarikat Malaysia (SSM) serta pertubuhan yang berdaftar dengan pihak berkuasa tempatan dan badan profesional.

### **6. METODOLOGI**

Anggaran upah pekerja dalam laporan ini adalah berdasarkan upah dan nilai caruman yang dilaporkan oleh majikan. Oleh kerana data dilaporkan secara tunai (semasa pembayaran dilakukan) dan bukannya asas akruan (masa pembayaran diperoleh), anggaran memerlukan penukaran data daripada asas tunai kepada asas akruan yang dilakukan melalui kaedah "*calendarisation*". Selain itu, untuk menangani sebarang jurang yang berpotensi atau ketidak lengkapkan dalam data, kaedah imputasi digunakan.

Bilangan pekerja dikira secara individu, di mana pekerja dengan pelbagai pekerjaan hanya akan dikira sekaligus. Pada masa yang sama, upah bagi individu yang mempunyai pelbagai pekerjaan adalah merujuk kepada jumlah upah yang diperoleh melalui semua pekerjaan yang dilakukan pada bulan rujukan.

Median merujuk kepada nilai yang terletak di tengah-tengah susunan suatu set nombor yang disusun secara tertib. Median upah digunakan untuk memberi gambaran "purata upah" yang lebih tepat kerana penentuan median tidak dipengaruhi nilai ekstrem.

## **7. PEMBUNDARAN**

Hasil tambah bagi sesuatu kategori mungkin berbeza dengan jumlah besar atau sub-jumlah kerana pembundaran.

## TECHNICAL NOTES

### 1. INTRODUCTION

*Employee Wages Statistics are compiled using administrative data from various agencies to monitor the performance of national wages and salaries. The statistics released cover the number of formal workers and median monthly wages. This technical note provides a detailed explanation of the concepts, definitions, scope, coverage and methodology used in the compilation of these statistics to help users better understand the wage information released.*

### 2. CONCEPT AND DEFINITION

**Employer** : Refer to an economic entity with whom the employee has a contract of service or apprenticeship, and is reported through the appropriate employment system.

**Formal Employee** : Refer to the person who works under a contract of service or apprenticeship with the employer and receives remuneration for the work completed. Formal employees do not include those who fall under non-standard employment, including self-employed, gig-workers, own-account workers, unpaid family workers, etc.

**Wages** : Refers to all remuneration in money payable made throughout the reference period to employees. The wage estimated includes bonuses, commissions and allowances per the data sources' definition. It does exclude service charges; overtime payments; gratuity; retirement benefits; retrenchment, lay-off or termination benefits; any travelling allowance or the value of any travelling concession; or any other remuneration or payment as may be exempted by the Minister.

*Wages do not include income from own businesses or other sources.*

**Economic Activity** : Economic activity is classified according to Malaysian Standard Industrial Classification (MSIC) 2008 which is based on the International Standard Industrial Classification of All Economic Activities (ISIC) Revision 4. The classification of sub-sectors and economic activities is as in exhibit below, with the Manufacturing and Services sectors can be detailed into eight sub-sectors.:

**Geographical** : Geographical location refers to the state where the employer is located. Employer information by state is obtained by integrating data sources with the statistical domain: Malaysia Statistical Business Register (MSBR).

**Ethnic** : The classification of the Malaysian formal employee's ethnic group is as follows:

- i. Bumiputera;
- ii. Chinese;
- iii. Indian; and
- iv. Others.

### **3. REFERENCE PERIOD**

*The statistics are based on the accrual basis in accordance with the 2008 System of National Accounts (SNA) recommendation, which reflects the month when the work is done regardless of when the payment is made or received.*

### **4. SCOPE AND COVERAGE**

*The release of these statistics is based on administrative data, including data on the mandatory contribution of retirement savings by the private and non-pensionable public sectors and data on the contribution of social security insurance obtained from various agencies which focus on citizen formal employees in Malaysia. The data does not cover employed persons fall under non-standard employment, including own-account workers and unpaid family workers.*

### **5. DATA SOURCES**

*The primary data sources for this publication comprise multiple administrative records provided by relevant agencies, i.e., Employees Provident Fund (EPF), Social Security Organisation (SOCSO) and others. Malaysia Statistical Business Register (MBSR), which comprises the list of establishments or enterprises operating in Malaysia gathered from the Register of Companies (ROC), Register of Businesses (ROB) and Limited Liability Partnership (LLP) registered with Companies Commission Malaysia (CCM) as well as establishment that is registered with the local authority and professional bodies also incorporated in the compilation.*

### **6. METHODOLOGY**

*The estimation of employee wages in this report is based on the wages and value of contributions reported by the employers. As the data are reported on a cash basis (the time when the payment was made) rather than an accrual basis (the time when the payment was earned), the estimates require the conversion of data from a cash basis to an accrual basis done through a "calendarisation" method. Moreover, to address any potential gaps or incompleteness in the data, an imputation method is applied.*

*The number of employees is calculated on an individual basis, in which the employee with multiple jobs will only be calculated at once. Correspondingly, wage for individual with multiple jobs is refer to the sum of all wages that are earned through all jobs performed in the reference month.*

*The median refers to the middle observation in a set of data that are arranged in a sequence. The median wage is used to give a more accurate picture of the "average wage", as the determination of the median is not affected by extreme values.*

## **7. ROUNDING**

*Due to rounding, the sum of component figures may not tally with the sub-total or total statistics.*

## **8. DETAIL OF STATISTICS**

*The statistics in this report are presented as follows:*

- ii. Ethnic;
- iii. Age group;
- iv. Economic activity;
- v. State.

## **9. REVISION**

*Data that underlie these estimates are subjected to revision which relates to receiving additional or more complete data over time, particularly the contribution value of which used in estimating the wage values.*

## **10. PRIVACY AND CONFIDENTIALITY**

*Legislative requirements stated in Statistics Act 1965 [Act 415] and Personal Data Protection Act 2010 [Act 709] to ensure the privacy and secrecy of this data have been followed. Furthermore, in accordance with the Census Act 1960 [Act 16], the results have been confidential to ensure that they are not likely to enable the identification of a particular person or organisation.*
