INDEKS PERDAGANGAN LUAR NEGERI, MALAYSIA, JUN 2025

Indeks Nilai Seunit Eksport mencatatkan pertumbuhan dengan kenaikan 2.1 peratus pada Jun 2025, disumbangkan terutamanya oleh Makanan, Pelbagai Barang Keluaran Kilang dan Alat Jentera & Kelengkapan Pengangkutan.

PUTRAJAYA, 28 JULAI 2025 – Indeks nilai seunit eksport Malaysia pada Jun 2025 mencatatkan kenaikan 2.1 peratus daripada 148.0 mata pada bulan sebelumnya kepada 151.2 mata. Manakala, indeks nilai seunit import mencatatkan kejatuhan 0.4 peratus daripada 124.8 mata kepada 124.4 mata. Terma Perdagangan Malaysia pula bertambah 2.5 peratus bulan ke bulan kepada 121.5 mata pada Jun 2025, sebagaimana dipaparkan oleh laporan **INDEKS PERDAGANGAN LUAR NEGERI (2010=100), JUN 2025** pada hari ini. Penerbitan ini memaparkan statistik indeks nilai seunit, indeks volum dan terma perdagangan meliputi 10 seksyen komoditi produk barang selaras dengan Klasifikasi Standard Perdagangan Antarabangsa (SITC).

Ketua Perangkawan Malaysia, Dato' Sri Dr. Mohd Uzir Mahidin menjelaskan indeks nilai seunit eksport naik 2.1 peratus pada Jun 2025 berbanding bulan sebelumnya, disumbangkan oleh kenaikan indeks pelbagai barang keluaran kilang (+0.8%), makanan (+0.3%) dan alat jentera & kelengkapan pengangkutan (+0.2%). Namun begitu, indeks volum eksport menyusut 5.9 peratus selaras dengan penurunan indeks barang-barang keluaran kilang (-19.3%), bahan kimia (-10.3%) dan pelbagai barang keluaran kilang (-5.4%). Indeks volum

eksport pelarasan bermusim juga turut susut 12.0 peratus daripada 166.1 mata kepada 146.1 mata. Merujuk kepada perbandingan tahunan, kedua-dua indeks nilai seunit dan indeks volum eksport jatuh 0.005 peratus dan 3.5 peratus.

Indeks nilai seunit import menurun 0.4 peratus pada Jun 2025, disumbangkan oleh penyusutan indeks minyak galian (-1.1%), bahan kimia (-0.5%) dan alat jentera & kelengkapan pengangkutan (-0.2%). Tambahan pula, indeks volum import juga turut jatuh 9.8 peratus pada Jun 2025 berbanding bulan sebelum, disumbangkan oleh penurunan dalam indeks alat jentera & kelengkapan pengangkutan (-16.4%), makanan (-13.1%) dan barang-barang keluaran kilang (-8.8%). Indeks volum import pelarasan bermusim menyusut 10.8 peratus daripada 232.8 mata kepada 207.8 mata. Perbandingan tahun ke tahun menunjukkan indeks nilai seunit import berkurang 4.7 peratus manakala indeks volum menaik 11.8 peratus.

Terma perdagangan Malaysia melonjak 2.5 peratus bulan ke bulan kepada 121.5 mata pada Jun 2025, didorong oleh kenaikan indeks pelbagai barang keluaran kilang (+0.8%), alat jentera & kelengkapan pengangkutan (+0.4%) dan makanan (+0.3%). Tambahan pula, terma perdagangan Malaysia tahun ke tahun turut bertambah 4.5 peratus daripada 116.3 mata pada Jun tahun lalu.


Kepengerusian ASEAN-Malaysia 2025: Jabatan Perangkaan Malaysia (DOSM) akan mempengerusikan Jawatankuasa Sistem Statistik Komuniti ASEAN Ke-15 (ACSS15) yang bertujuan untuk memperkuuh kerjasama statistik ke arah pembangunan serantau yang mampan.

Malaysia buat julung kalinya telah menduduki tangga pertama (1) di peringkat global dalam laporan dwi-tahunan Open Data Inventory (ODIN) 2024/25 yang dikeluarkan oleh Open Data Watch (ODW), mengatasi 198 negara lain. Pencapaian ini merupakan lonjakan ketara daripada kedudukan ke-67 dalam penilaian ODIN 2022/23.

Kerajaan Malaysia telah mengisytiharkan 20 Oktober sebagai Hari Statistik Negara (MyStats Day), dengan tema 'Statistik Nadi Kehidupan'. Sementara itu, Hari Statistik Dunia Keempat akan disambut pada 20 Oktober 2025 dengan tema '*Driving Change with Quality*

Statistics and Data for Everyone'.

EXTERNAL TRADE INDICES, MALAYSIA, JUNE 2025

The Export Unit Value Index registered a growth with an increase by 2.1 per cent in June 2025, mainly contributed by Food, Miscellaneous Manufactured Articles and Machinery & Transport Equipment.

PUTRAJAYA, JULY 28, 2025 – Malaysia's export unit value index in June 2025 registered an increase by 2.1 per cent from 148.0 points in the previous month to 151.2 points. Meanwhile, import unit value index fell of 0.4 per cent from 124.8 points to 124.4 points. Malaysia's terms of trade rose by 2.5 per cent month-on-month to 121.5 points in June 2025 as reported today in **EXTERNAL TRADE INDICES (2010=100), JUNE 2025**. This publication presents the unit value index, volume index and terms of trade for 10 commodity sections of merchandise products in accordance with the Standard International Trade Classification (SITC).

Chief Statistician Malaysia, Dato' Sri Dr. Mohd Uzir Mahidin highlighted, the export unit value index grew by 2.1 per cent in June 2025 as compared to the previous month. This increment was primarily driven by the rises in the index of miscellaneous manufactured articles (+0.8%), food (+0.3%) and machinery & transport equipment (+0.2%). On the other note, the export volume index dropped by 5.9 per cent in line with the decrease in the index of manufactured goods (-19.3%), chemicals (-10.3%) and miscellaneous manufactured articles (-5.4%). The seasonally adjusted export volume index also dropped by 12.0 per cent from

166.1 points to 146.1 points. Referring to the annual comparison, both the exports unit value index and volume index went down by 0.005 per cent and 3.5 per cent respectively.

The import unit value index fell 0.4 per cent in June 2025, contributed by the decline in the index of mineral fuels (-1.1%), chemicals (-0.5%) and machinery & transport equipment (-0.2%). Furthermore, the import volume index also dropped by 9.8 per cent in June 2025 as compared to the previous month, contributed by the decrement in the index of machinery & transport equipment (-16.4%), food (-13.1%) and manufactured goods (-8.8%). The seasonally adjusted import volume index decreased by 10.8 per cent from 232.8 points to 207.8 points. A year-on-year comparison showed that the unit value index edged down by 4.7 per cent while volume index edged up by 11.8 per cent.

Malaysia's terms of trade soar 2.5 per cent month-on-month to 121.5 points in June 2025, driven by the increase in the index of miscellaneous manufactured articles (+0.8%), machinery & transport equipment (+0.4%) and food (+0.3%). In addition, Malaysia's terms of trade also rose 4.5 per cent year-on-year from 116.3 points in June previous year.

ASEAN-Malaysia 2025 Chairmanship: Department of Statistics Malaysia (DOSM) will chair the 15th ASEAN Community Statistical System Committee (ACSS15) which aims to strengthen the statistical cooperation towards sustainable regional development.

Malaysia, for the first time, ranked as number one (1) globally in the biennial Open Data Inventory (ODIN) 2024/25 report released by Open Data Watch (ODW), surpassing 198 other countries. This achievement marks a significant leap from its 67th position in the ODIN 2022/23 assessment.

The Government of Malaysia has declared October 20th as National Statistics Day (MyStats Day), with the theme 'Statistics is the Essence of Life'. Meanwhile, the Fourth World Statistics Day will be celebrated on 20th October 2025, with the theme 'Driving Change with Quality Statistics and Data for Everyone'.




Chart 1: Month-on-Month Percentage Change of Export & Import Unit Value Indices
