Kepengerusian ASEAN-Malaysia 2025: Jabatan Perangkaan Malaysia (DOSM) akan mempengerusikan Jawatankuasa Sistem Statistik Komuniti ASEAN Ke-15 (ACSS15) yang bertujuan untuk memperkukuh kerjasama statistik ke arah pembangunan serantau yang mampan.

Malaysia buat julung kalinya telah menduduki tangga pertama (1) di peringkat global dalam laporan dwi-tahunan *Open Data Inventory* (ODIN) 2024/25 yang dikeluarkan oleh *Open Data Watch* (ODW), mengatasi 198 negara lain. Pencapaian ini merupakan lonjakan ketara daripada kedudukan ke-67 dalam penilaian ODIN 2022/23.

Kerajaan Malaysia telah mengisytiharkan 20 Oktober sebagai Hari Statistik Negara (MyStats Day), dengan tema 'Statistik Nadi Kehidupan'. Sementara itu, Hari Statistik Dunia Keempat akan disambut pada 20 Oktober 2025 dengan tema '*Driving Change with Quality Statistics and Data for Everyone*'.

OpenDOSM NextGen adalah medium yang menyediakan katalog data dan visualisasi bagi memudahkan pengguna menganalisis pelbagai data dan boleh diakses melalui portal <https://open.dosm.gov.my>.

ASEAN-Malaysia 2025 Chairmanship: The Department of Statistics Malaysia (DOSM) will chair the 15th ASEAN Community Statistical System Committee (ACSS15) which aims to strengthen the statistical cooperation towards sustainable regional development.

Malaysia, for the first time, ranked as number one (1) globally in the biennial Open Data Inventory (ODIN) 2024/25 report released by Open Data Watch (ODW), surpassing 198 other countries. This achievement marks a significant leap from its 67th position in the ODIN 2022/23 assessment.

*The Government of Malaysia has declared October 20th as National Statistics Day (MyStats Day), with the theme 'Statistics is the Essence of Life.' Meanwhile, the Fourth World Statistics Day will be celebrated on 20th October 2025, with the theme '*Driving Change with Quality Statistics and Data for Everyone*'.*

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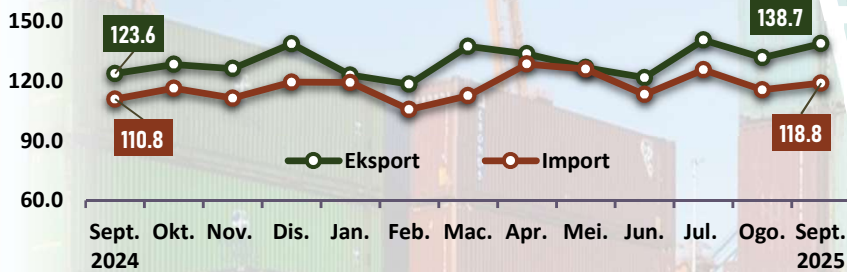

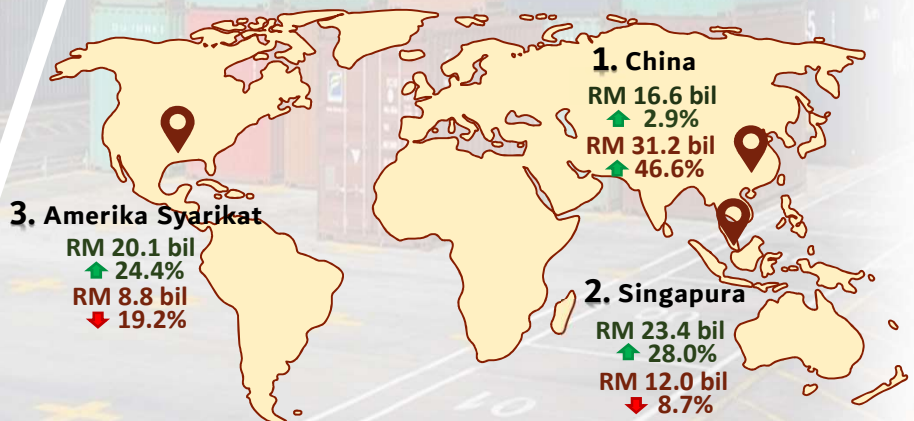

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PRESTASI PERDAGANGAN LUAR NEGERI MALAYSIA, SEPTEMBER 2025

Prestasi perdagangan Malaysia kembali mencatatkan pertumbuhan positif pada September 2025 sejajar dengan peningkatan eksport dan import. Jumlah perdagangan bertambah RM23.1 bilion atau 9.8 peratus, tahun ke tahun, untuk mencecah nilai RM257.5 bilion. Imbangan dagangan turut meningkat 54.7 peratus kepada RM19.9 bilion berbanding RM12.8 bilion pada bulan yang sama tahun sebelumnya.

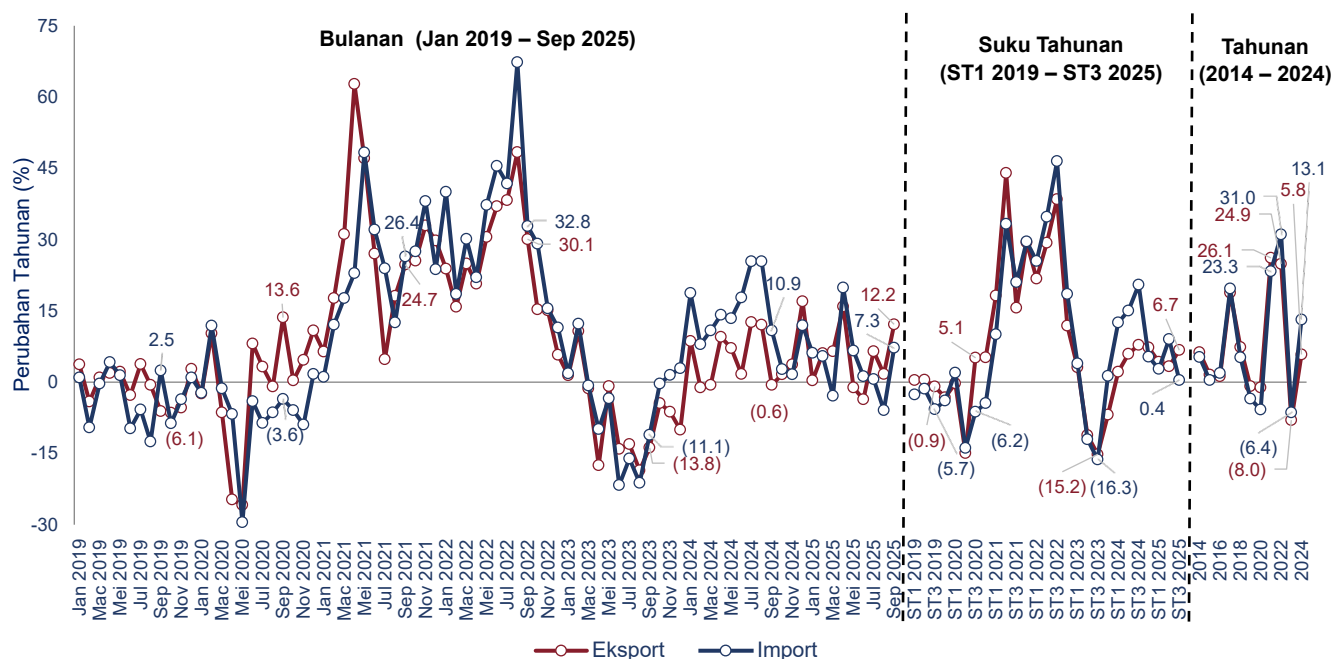
Perbandingan secara bulanan menunjukkan jumlah perdagangan dan lebih dagangan

menokok masing-masing 4.3 peratus dan 25.3 peratus.

Bagi tempoh Januari hingga September 2025, eksport naik 4.8 peratus, import berkembang 4.0 peratus, jumlah dagangan mengukuh 4.4 peratus dan imbangan dagangan meningkat 13.6 peratus.

Bagi suku tahun ketiga 2025, prestasi baik ditunjukkan dengan pengukuhan eksport (+6.7%), import (0.4%), jumlah dagangan (+3.7%) dan imbangan dagangan (+93.6%).

Prestasi Eksport Malaysia mengukuh pada September 2025, dengan pertumbuhan dua angka

Prestasi Eksport

Pada September 2025, prestasi eksport Malaysia mencatatkan pertumbuhan memberangsangkan dengan peningkatan 12.2 peratus daripada RM123.6 bilion pada September 2024 kepada RM138.7 bilion.

Pertumbuhan ini sejajar dengan peningkatan ketara eksport semula yang merangkumi

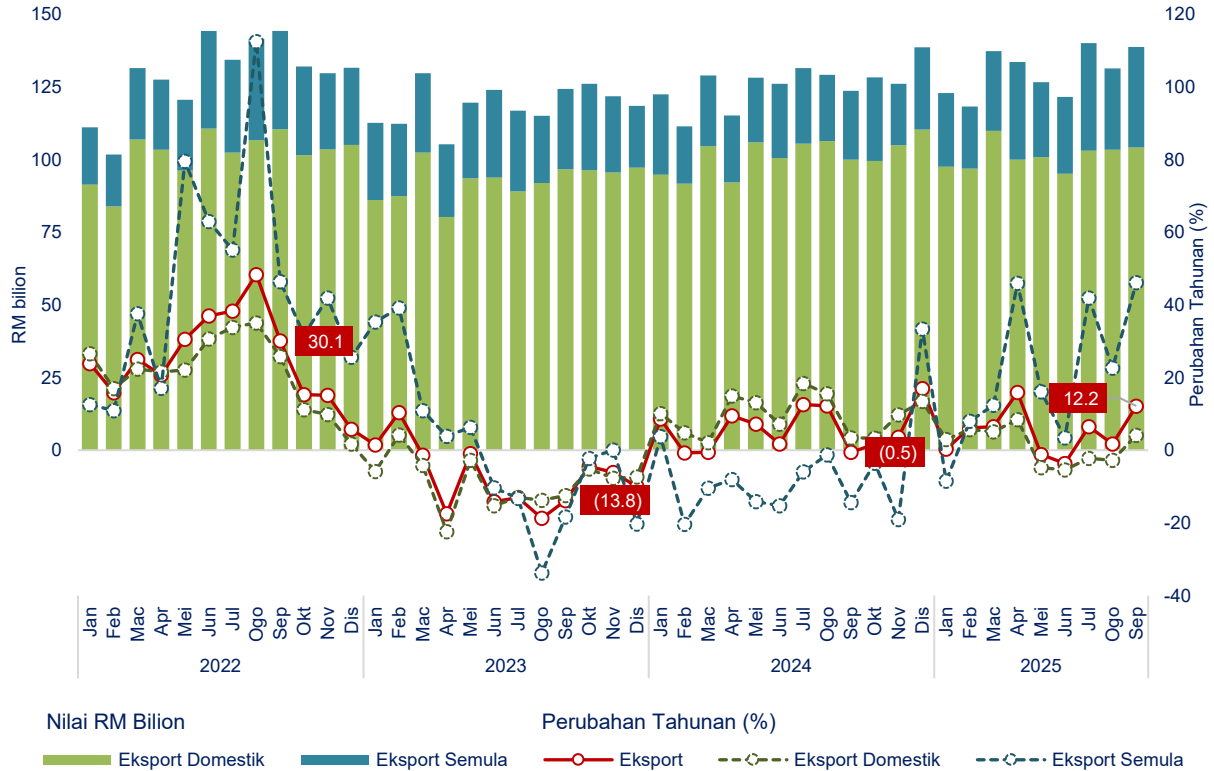
24.9 peratus daripada jumlah eksport, melonjak 46.1 peratus kepada RM34.5 bilion.

Manakala, eksport domestik bertumbuh 4.2 peratus kepada RM104.2 bilion, mewakili 75.1 peratus daripada jumlah eksport.

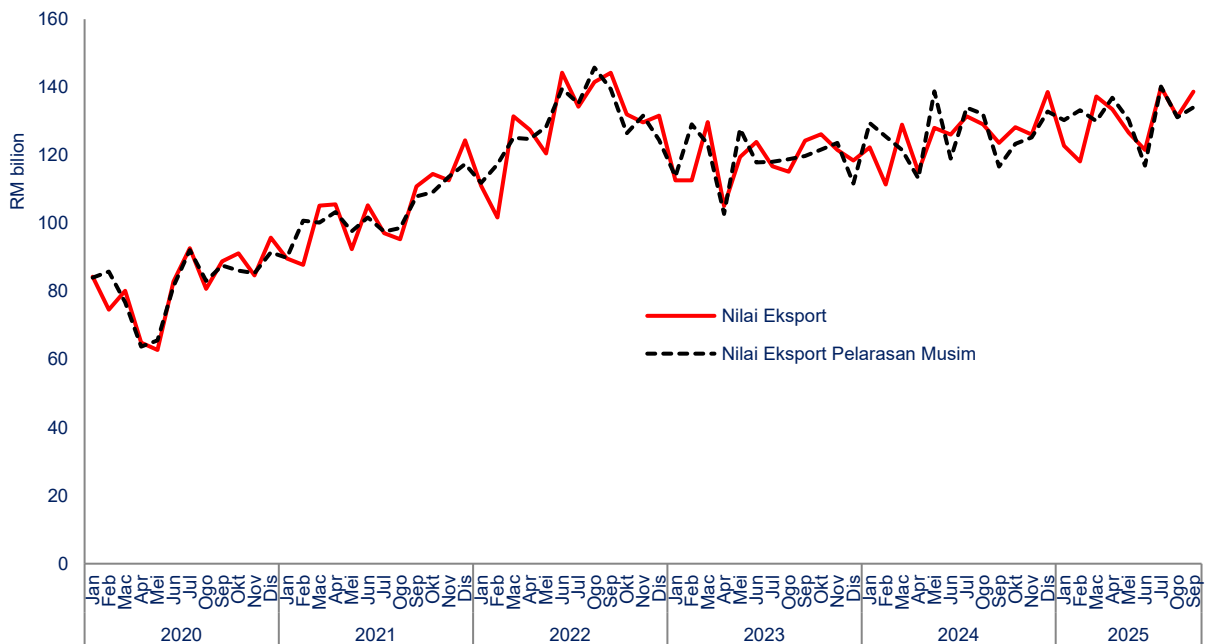
Perbandingan bulan ke bulan menunjukkan eksport semula meningkat 23.5 peratus dan eksport domestik naik secara marginal

0.8 peratus. Analisis terma pelarasan musim bulan ke bulan menunjukkan eksport meningkat 2.3 peratus kepada RM134.1 bilion.

Prestasi Eksport mengikut Negara Destinasi Utama

Singapura dan Amerika Syarikat menjadi negara destinasi utama pada September 2025 dengan sumbangan berjumlah 31.3 peratus kepada jumlah eksport Malaysia.

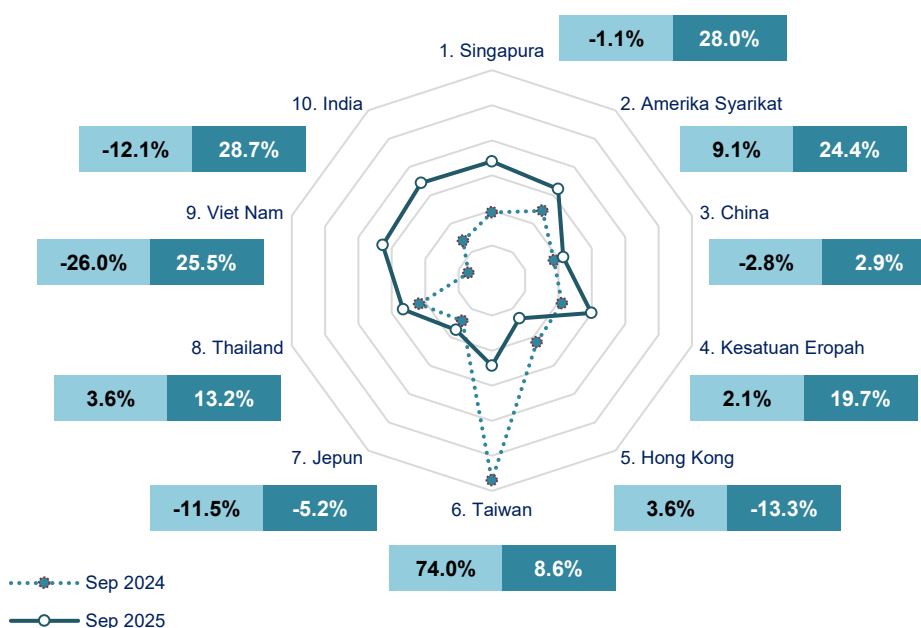
Eksport ke Singapura bernilai RM23.4 bilion, mewakili 16.9 peratus daripada jumlah eksport, mencatatkan peningkatan 28.0 peratus atau RM5.1 bilion, tahun ke tahun. Pertumbuhan ini disokong terutamanya oleh eksport yang lebih tinggi barangan elektrik & elektronik (+RM4.8 bilion, +54.6%), barangan optik & saintifik (+RM103.5 juta, +20.0%), petroleum mentah (+RM93.2 juta, +100.0%), jentera, kelengkapan & alat ganti (+RM70.8 juta, +4.2%).

Sementara itu, eksport ke Amerika Syarikat sebagai negara destinasi kedua tertinggi pada

September 2025, berjumlah RM20.1 bilion dan menyumbang 14.5 peratus kepada jumlah eksport Malaysia, meningkat 24.4 peratus atau RM3.9 bilion, tahun ke tahun. Peningkatan ini dipacu oleh eksport yang lebih tinggi barangan elektrik & elektronik (+RM2.4 bilion, +23.3%); keluaran perkilangan lain (+RM422.4 juta, +39.3%); besi & keluli (+RM409.7 juta, +295.2%); barangan optik & saintifik (+RM370.6 juta, +40.6%); jentera, kelengkapan & alat ganti (+RM242.5 juta, +40.8%) dan makanan diproses (+RM105.5 juta, +61.6%).

Eksport ke sepuluh negara destinasi utama mencatatkan perkembangan kecuali eksport ke Hong Kong dan Jepun.

Eksport ke Negara ASEAN

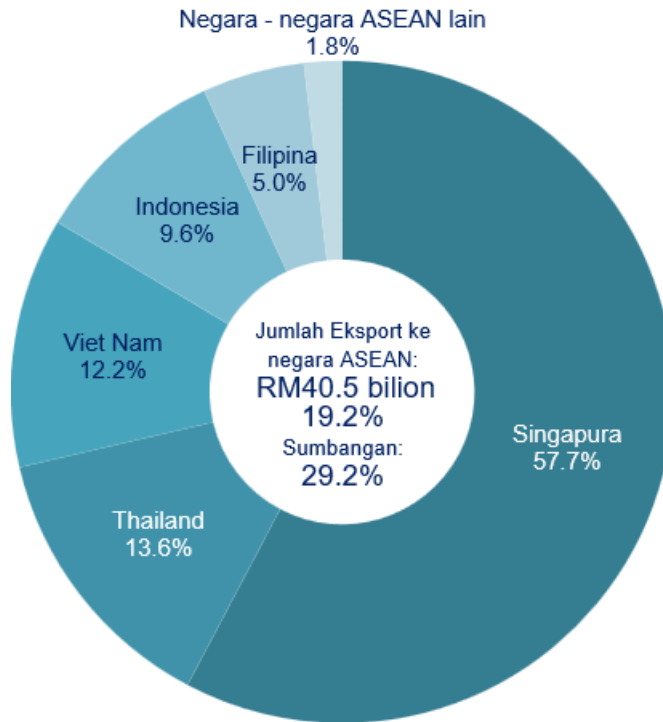
Eksport ke negara ASEAN mewakili 29.2 peratus daripada jumlah eksport Malaysia dengan mencatatkan nilai RM40.5 bilion, bertumbuh 19.2 peratus berbanding bulan yang sama tahun 2024.

Kenaikan ini disumbangkan terutamanya oleh eksport barangan elektrik & elektronik yang meningkat 50.3 peratus atau RM6.4 bilion, dan

barangan optik & saintifik (+RM272.5 juta, +33.3%).

Singapura terus menjadi destinasi utama dengan menyumbang lebih separuh daripada jumlah eksport keseluruhan ke negara anggota ASEAN (57.7%) dengan mencatatkan nilai RM23.4 bilion, berkembang 28.0 peratus berbanding tahun sebelumnya.

Carta 5: Peratusan Sumbangan Eksport ke Negara ASEAN, September 2025



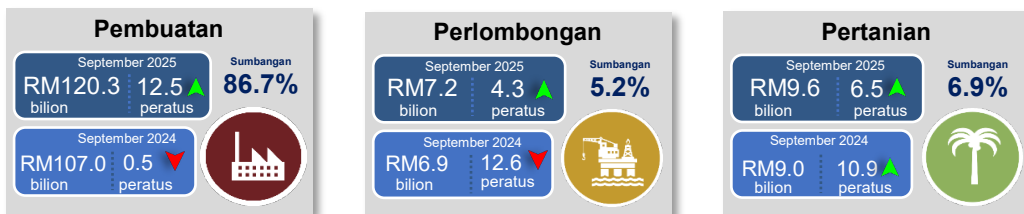
Prestasi Eksport mengikut Sektor Ekonomi

Eksport barangan perkilangan meningkat 12.5 peratus atau RM13.3 bilion pada September 2025, menyumbang 86.7 peratus kepada jumlah eksport. Peningkatan ini didorong oleh pertambahan eksport barangan elektrik & elektronik (+RM10.6 bilion, +19.5%), diikuti oleh jentera, kelengkapan & peralatan (+RM813.9 juta, +14.7%), keluaran perkilangan lain (+RM809.8 juta, +17.0%); barangan optik & saintifik (+RM809.0 juta, +16.7%) dan keluaran perkilangan berasaskan minyak kelapa sawit (+RM768.5 juta, +27.4%).

Eksport hasil perlombongan yang mewakili 5.2 peratus daripada jumlah eksport, menokok 4.3 peratus kepada RM7.2 bilion, berikutan eksport yang lebih tinggi bagi bijih logam & serpihan logam dengan peningkatan RM988.8 juta atau 163.1 peratus.

Eksport keluaran pertanian yang mewakili 6.9 peratus daripada jumlah eksport mencatatkan pertumbuhan 6.5 peratus kepada RM9.6 bilion. Peningkatan itu adalah sejajar dengan kenaikan eksport minyak kelapa sawit & hasil pertanian berasaskan minyak kelapa sawit (+RM587.6 juta, +8.6%).

Eksport mengikut Produk Utama Terpilih

Peningkatan ketara prestasi eksport pada September 2025 dipengaruhi oleh peningkatan dalam produk berikut:

- Barangan elektrik & elektronik, meliputi 47.0 peratus daripada jumlah eksport, berkembang 19.5 peratus, berjumlah RM54.5 bilion pada tahun sebelumnya kepada RM65.1 bilion;
- Minyak kelapa sawit & hasil keluaran berasaskan minyak kelapa sawit (8.0% daripada jumlah eksport), meningkat 14.0 peratus atau RM1.4 bilion kepada RM11.0 bilion. Bagaimanapun, eksport minyak sawit, komoditi utama dalam kumpulan produk ini mencatatkan pengurangan RM73.3 juta atau 1.3 peratus, seiring dengan penurunan volum eksport (-7.1%). Seterusnya, harga minyak sawit tempatan meningkat 8.6 peratus kepada RM4,371.5 per tan metrik; dan
- Keluaran petroleum bertapis, merangkumi 5.8 peratus daripada jumlah eksport, menokok 7.6 peratus atau RM565.7 juta kepada RM8.0 bilion, selaras dengan peningkatan volum eksport 18.8 peratus, sebaliknya nilai purata seunit menurun 9.4 peratus.

Walau bagaimanapun, penurunan telah direkodkan untuk produk berikut:

- Gas asli cecair menyumbang 2.7 peratus kepada jumlah eksport, menurun RM563.5 juta atau 13.2 peratus kepada RM3.7 bilion. Ia selaras dengan penurunan nilai purata seunit 17.2 peratus, namun volum eksport meningkat 4.8 peratus;
- Petroleum mentah yang merangkumi 1.0 peratus daripada jumlah eksport, susut RM298.4 juta atau 17.3 peratus kepada RM1.4 bilion walaupun dengan pertambahan volum eksport (+2.9%). Seajar dengan penurunan harga minyak Brent kepada RM286.2 setong menjana penurunan nilai purata seunit 19.6 peratus;
- Kayu & hasil keluaran kayu turun 5.5 peratus atau RM100.3 juta kepada RM1.7 bilion, seterusnya menyumbang 1.2 peratus kepada jumlah eksport; dan
- Getah asli yang mencakupi 0.2 peratus daripada jumlah eksport, menyusut 16.2 peratus atau RM51.0 juta kepada RM264.2 juta. Ia selaras dengan pengurangan volum eksport (-16.0%) dan nilai purata seunit (-0.2%), selaras dengan penurunan harga getah SMR20 (-9.6%).

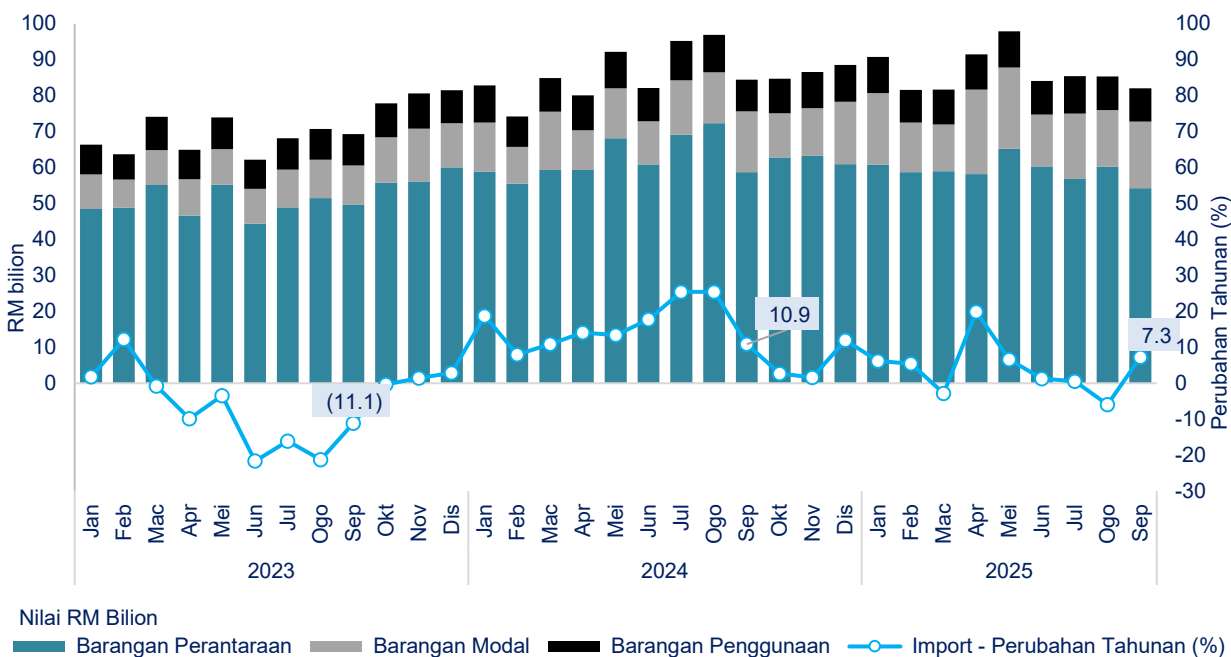
Import kembali mencatatkan pertumbuhan positif

Prestasi Import

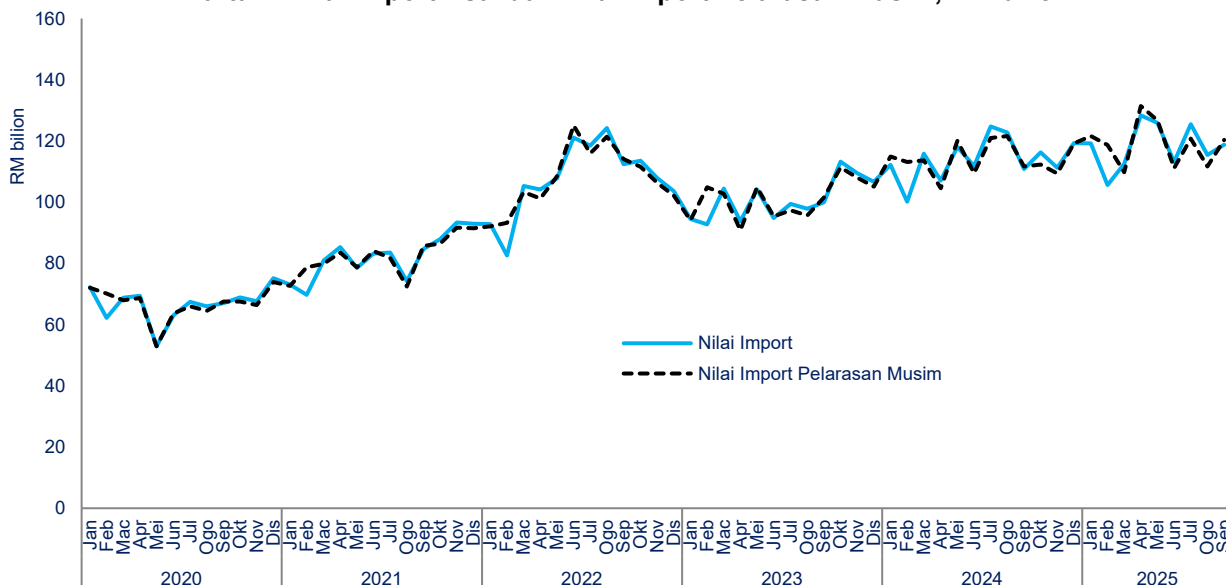
Import Malaysia pada September 2025 kembali memulih dengan mencatatkan peningkatan 7.3 peratus atau RM8.0 bilion untuk mencecah nilai RM118.8 bilion. Berdasarkan bulan ke bulan, import turut meningkat 2.9 peratus atau RM3.4 bilion. Merujuk kepada analisis terma pelarasan musim bulan ke bulan, import meningkat 7.8 peratus kepada RM120.4 bilion.

Perbandingan tahun ke tahun, import mengikut Penggunaan Akhir mencatatkan pertumbuhan positif dengan peningkatan dalam barangan modal (+9.3%) dan barangan penggunaan (+5.1%), namun sebaliknya bagi barangan perantaraan yang mengalami kemerosotan 7.6 peratus.

Prestasi Import Mengikut Negara Asal Utama

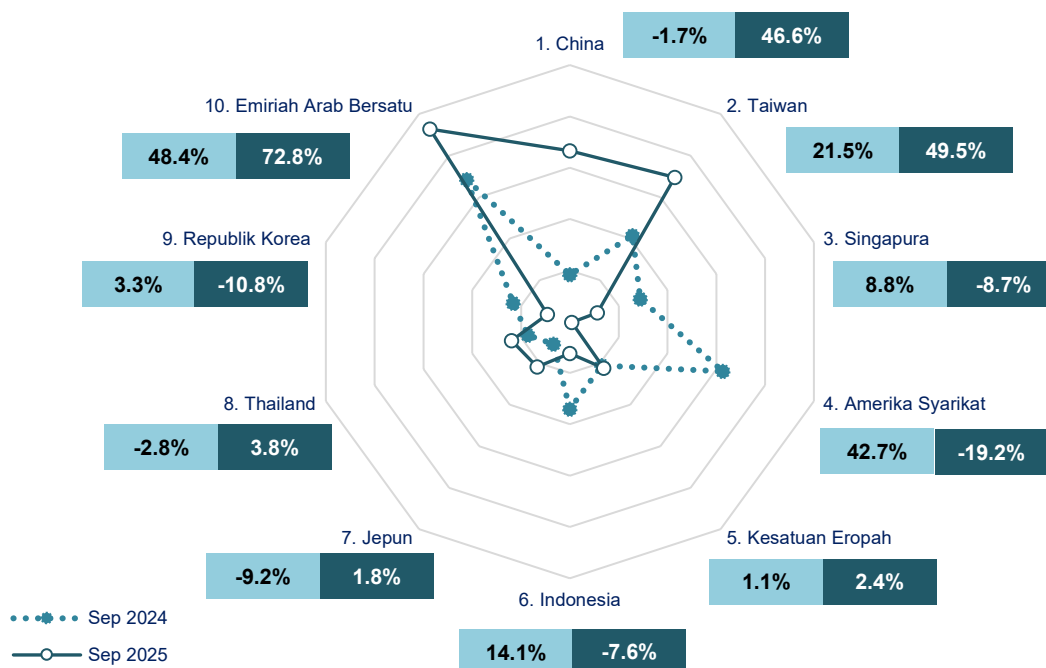
China dan Taiwan merupakan dua negara asal utama bagi import Malaysia pada September 2025 dengan sumbangan 36.7 peratus kepada jumlah import.

Import dari China yang mewakili 26.3 peratus daripada import Malaysia, meningkat 46.6 peratus kepada RM31.2 bilion. Pertumbuhan ini dirangsang oleh import yang tinggi barangan elektrik & elektronik dengan peningkatan 81.1 peratus atau RM7.0 bilion, diikuti oleh kelengkapan pengangkutan (+RM472.0 juta, +54.4%), barangan keluaran lain (+RM452.7 juta, +72.5%), keluaran perkilangan logam (+RM318.7 juta, +21.7%), kimia & bahan kimia (+RM295.9 juta, +18.2%), keluaran petroleum (+RM259.5 juta, +59.6%) dan jentera, kelengkapan & alat ganti (+RM226.9 juta, +7.8%).

Import dari Taiwan bernilai RM12.4 bilion, merangkumi 10.4 peratus daripada import Malaysia, meningkat 49.5 peratus atau RM4.1 bilion, tahun ke tahun. Pertumbuhan ini disumbangkan terutamanya oleh import barangan elektrik & elektronik yang lebih tinggi (+RM3.7 bilion, +56.0%), barangan keluaran lain (+RM227.8 juta, +498.7%), dan jentera, kelengkapan & alat ganti (+RM190.6 juta, +123.9%) dan keluaran petroleum (+RM175.1 juta, +30.1%).

Perubahan tahunan import sepuluh negara asal utama mencatatkan peningkatan kecuali dari Singapura, Amerika Syarikat, Indonesia dan Republik Korea berbanding tempoh yang sama tahun lepas.

Carta 8: Perubahan Tahunan Import bagi Negara Asal Utama, September 2024 dan September 2025



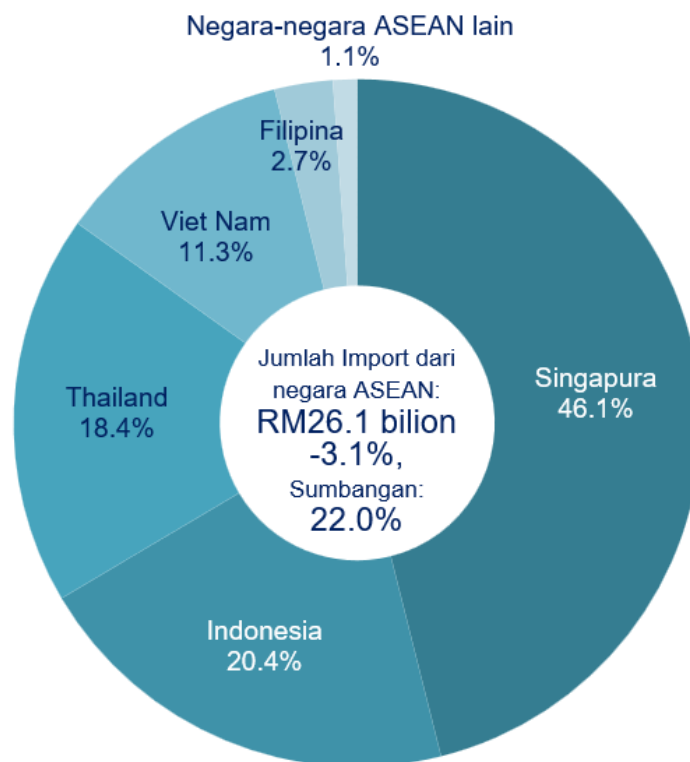
Import dari Negara ASEAN

Import dari negara ASEAN menguncup dengan penurunan 3.1 peratus pada September 2025 kepada RM26.1 bilion, mewakili 22.0 peratus daripada jumlah import Malaysia. Penyusutan ini disumbangkan terutamanya oleh import yang rendah keluaran petroleum

(-RM820.8 juta, -18.9%) dan kelengkapan pengangkutan (-RM498.3 juta, -35.0%).

Dalam kalangan negara utama ASEAN, penurunan dilihat bagi import dari Singapura, Indonesia, Filipina dan Myanmar.

Prestasi Import Mengikut Sektor Ekonomi

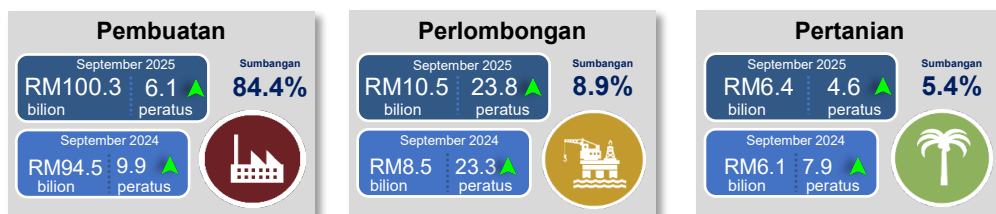
Barangan perkilangan yang merangkumi 84.4 peratus daripada jumlah import, meningkat 6.1 peratus daripada RM94.5 bilion kepada RM100.3 bilion, tahun ke tahun. Prestasi ini didorong oleh import barangan elektrik & elektronik yang lebih tinggi (+RM4.9 bilion, +12.1%); jentera, kelengkapan & alat ganti (+RM973.0 juta, +11.1%) dan keluaran perkilangan lain (+RM961.1 juta, +47.4%).

Import hasil perlombongan berjumlah RM10.5 bilion, melonjak 23.8 peratus berbanding tahun sebelumnya dan menyumbang 8.9 peratus

kepada jumlah import Malaysia. Pertumbuhan ini disebabkan oleh import petroleum mentah yang lebih tinggi (+RM1.8 bilion, +37.0%) dan bijih logam & serpihan logam (+RM503.2 juta, +52.3%).

Import keluaran pertanian (5.4% daripada jumlah import) berkembang 4.6 peratus atau RM282.0 juta kepada RM6.4 bilion, disokong oleh import lebih tinggi minyak kelapa sawit & keluaran berasaskan minyak kelapa sawit (+RM614.5 juta, +253.5%) dan makanan laut, segar, sejuk atau beku (+RM26.7 juta, +8.1%).

Import mengikut Produk Utama Terpilih

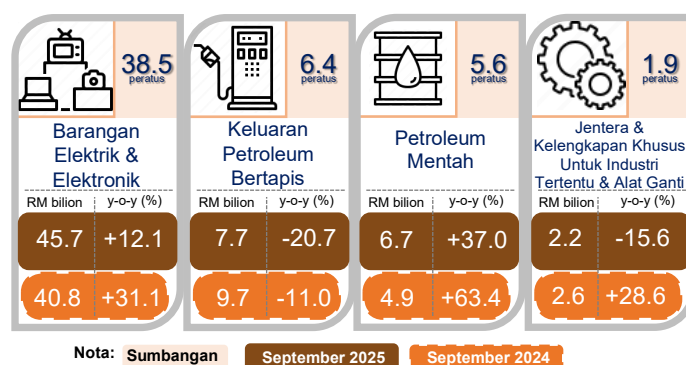
Import menunjukkan prestasi memberangsangkan pada September 2025, dengan pertumbuhan positif dilihat dalam produk berikut:

- Barangan elektrik & elektronik menyumbang 38.5 peratus kepada jumlah import, meningkat RM4.9 bilion atau 12.1 peratus kepada RM45.7 bilion; dan
- Petroleum mentah menyumbang 5.6 peratus kepada jumlah import, bertambah RM1.8 bilion atau 37.0 peratus kepada RM6.7 bilion, selaras dengan kenaikan volum import (+55.9%). Namun sebaliknya, penurunan bagi nilai purata seunit (-12.1%) dan harga minyak Brent (-9.6%) kepada RM286.2 setong.

Walau bagaimanapun, pertumbuhan negatif direkodkan bagi produk berikut:

- Keluaran petroleum bertapis menyumbang 6.4 peratus kepada jumlah import, mencatatkan penurunan RM2.0 bilion atau 20.7 peratus kepada RM7.7 bilion, dengan penyusutan volum import (-6.7%) serta nilai purata seunit (-15.1%); dan
- Jentera & kelengkapan khusus untuk industri tertentu & alat ganti yang menyumbang 1.9 peratus kepada jumlah import, jatuh 15.6 peratus atau RM411.3 juta kepada RM2.2 bilion.

Import mengikut Klasifikasi Penggunaan Akhir & Kategori Ekonomi Umum

Jumlah import pada September 2025 bernilai RM118.8 bilion, meningkat 7.3 peratus berbanding bulan yang sama tahun sebelumnya. Tiga kategori utama import mengikut Penggunaan Akhir yang merangkumi 69.0 peratus daripada jumlah import ialah:

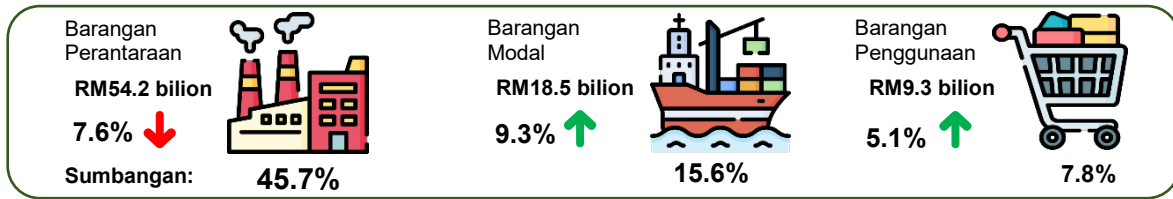
Barangan perantaraan, bernilai RM54.2 bilion atau 45.7 peratus daripada jumlah import, menyusut 7.6 peratus disebabkan import yang lebih rendah bagi alat ganti & aksesori barangan modal (kecuali peralatan pengangkutan) (-RM3.6 bilion, -19.3%) dan bahan api & pelincir, diproses, lain-lain (-RM3.2 bilion, -64.7%).

Barangan modal, berjumlah RM18.5 bilion (15.6% daripada jumlah import) meningkat 9.3 peratus, disebabkan oleh import yang lebih tinggi bagi barangan modal (kecuali alat

kelengkapan pengangkutan) (+RM1.0 bilion, +6.4%) dan peralatan pengangkutan, perindustrian (+RM548.7 juta, +67.8%).

Barangan penggunaan, berjumlah RM9.3 bilion (7.8% daripada jumlah import), mencatatkan pertambahan 5.1 peratus, disumbang oleh import barangan tahan lama (+RM360.4 juta, +27.8%) dan makanan dan minuman, diproses, khusus untuk penggunaan isirumah (+RM232.1 juta, +8.2%).

EKSPORT DAN IMPORT MENGIKUT LOKASI

Malaysia mencatatkan jumlah perdagangan bernilai RM257.5 bilion pada September 2025 dengan eksport dan import masing-masing bernilai RM138.7 bilion dan RM118.8 bilion.

Eksport bernilai RM138.7 bilion pada September 2025, meningkat sebanyak RM15.1 bilion (+12.2%) berbanding bulan yang sama tahun sebelumnya. Peningkatan eksport dipengaruhi oleh eksport yang lebih tinggi di Pulau Pinang (+RM11.5 bilion), Johor (+RM3.5 bilion), Selangor (+RM662.0 juta), Perak (+RM135.7 juta), Sabah (+RM105.5 juta), Negeri Sembilan (+RM99.1 juta), Perlis (+RM5.7 juta) dan Melaka (+RM2.5 juta). Walau bagaimanapun, nilai eksport menurun di Kedah sebanyak RM515.3 juta, Sarawak (-RM359.4 juta), W.P. Labuan (-RM46.5 juta), Pahang (-RM35.5 juta), Terengganu (-RM15.2 juta), W.P. Kuala Lumpur (-RM7.3 juta) dan Kelantan (-RM0.7 juta).

Pulau Pinang kekal sebagai pengeksport utama dengan sumbangan 41.6 peratus, diikuti oleh

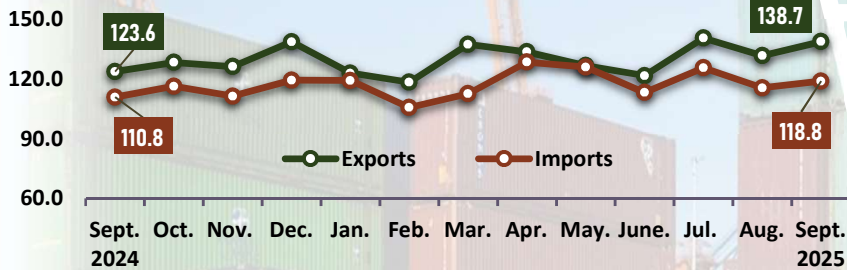
Johor (19.8%), Selangor (15.1%), Sarawak (5.6%) dan W.P. Kuala Lumpur (3.7%).

Pada masa yang sama, import pada bulan September 2025 meningkat RM8.0 bilion (+7.3%) berbanding bulan yang sama pada tahun 2024. Peningkatan import disebabkan oleh import yang lebih tinggi di kebanyakan negeri iaitu W.P. Kuala Lumpur (+RM4.4 bilion), Pulau Pinang (+RM2.2 bilion), Johor (+RM2.0 bilion), Perak (+RM342.8 juta), Negeri Sembilan (+RM335.3 juta), Sabah (+RM302.9 juta), Sarawak (+RM201.6 juta), Melaka (+RM117.9 juta), Perlis (+RM37.4 juta) dan W.P. Labuan (+RM36.7 juta). Walau bagaimanapun, nilai import menurun di Selangor sebanyak RM739.2 juta, Kedah (-RM656.2 juta), Terengganu (-RM254.7 juta), Pahang (-RM183.8 juta) dan Kelantan (-RM2.9 juta).

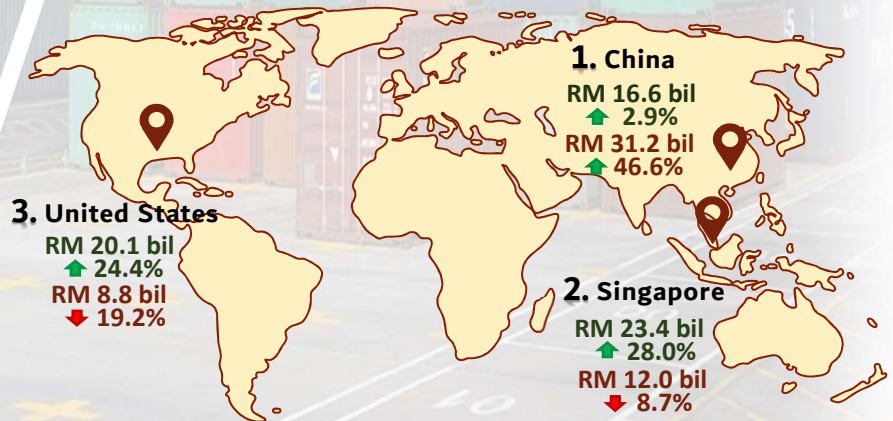

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MALAYSIA'S EXTERNAL TRADE PERFORMANCE, SEPTEMBER 2025

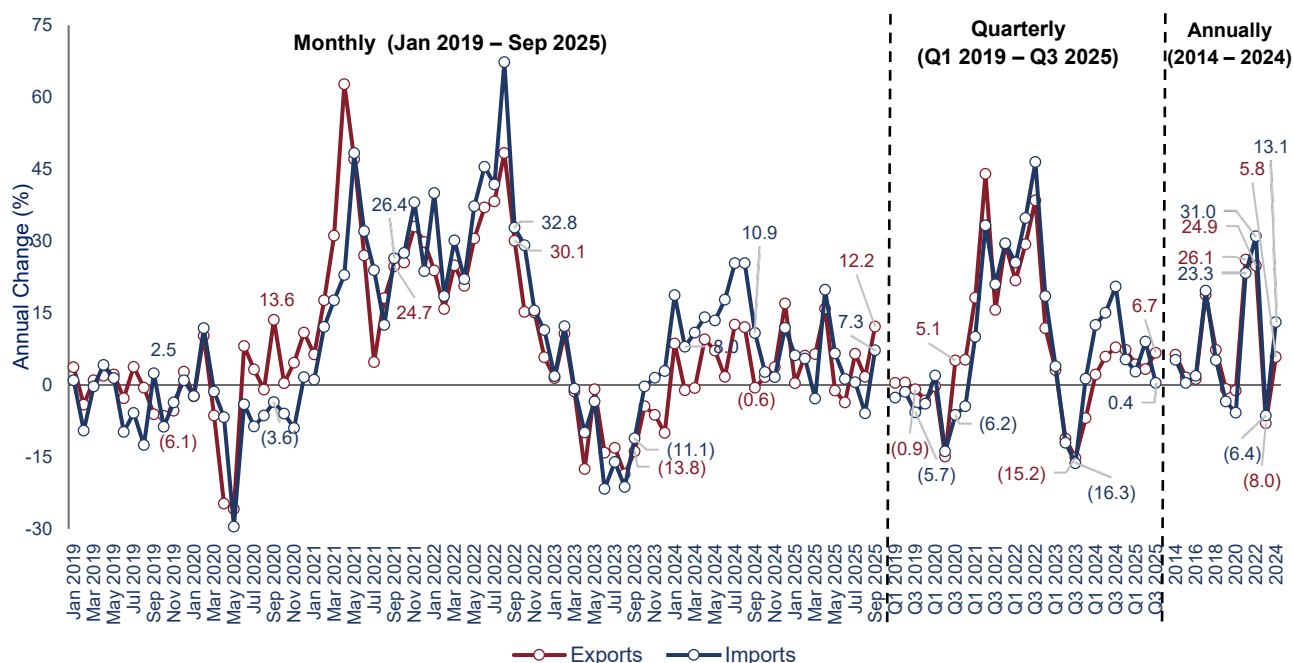
Malaysia's trade performance rebounded to positive growth in September 2025 in line with the increase in both exports and imports. Total trade rose by RM23.1 billion or 9.8 per cent, year-on-year (y-o-y), to reach a value of RM257.5 billion. Trade surplus also surged by 54.7 per cent to RM19.9 billion compared to RM12.8 billion in the same month of the previous year.

Month-on-month (m-o-m) comparison showed that total trade and trade surplus expanded by 4.3 per cent and 25.3 per cent, respectively.

For the period of January to September 2025, exports increased by 4.8 per cent, imports grew by 4.0 per cent, total trade strengthened by 4.4 per cent and trade surplus rose by 13.6 per cent.

In the third quarter of 2025, good performance was shown with notable growth in exports (+6.7%), imports (+0.4%), total trade (+3.7%) and trade surplus (+93.6%).

EXPORTS

Malaysia's export performance strengthened in September 2025, posting double-digit growth

Performance of Exports

In September 2025, Malaysia's exports posted a robust increase of 12.2 per cent, rising from RM123.6 billion in September 2024 to RM138.7 billion.

This growth aligned with a sharp increase in re-exports which accounted for 24.9 per cent of

total exports, soaring by 46.1 per cent to RM34.5 billion.

Meanwhile, domestic exports grew by 4.2 per cent to RM104.2 billion, representing 75.1 per cent of total exports.

On a m-o-m basis, re-exports climbed by 23.5 per cent, while domestic exports edged up marginally by 0.8 per cent. Seasonally adjusted

terms m-o-m analysis indicated that exports grew by 2.3 per cent to RM134.1 billion.

Chart 2: Domestic Exports, Re-Exports (RM billion) and Annual Change (%)

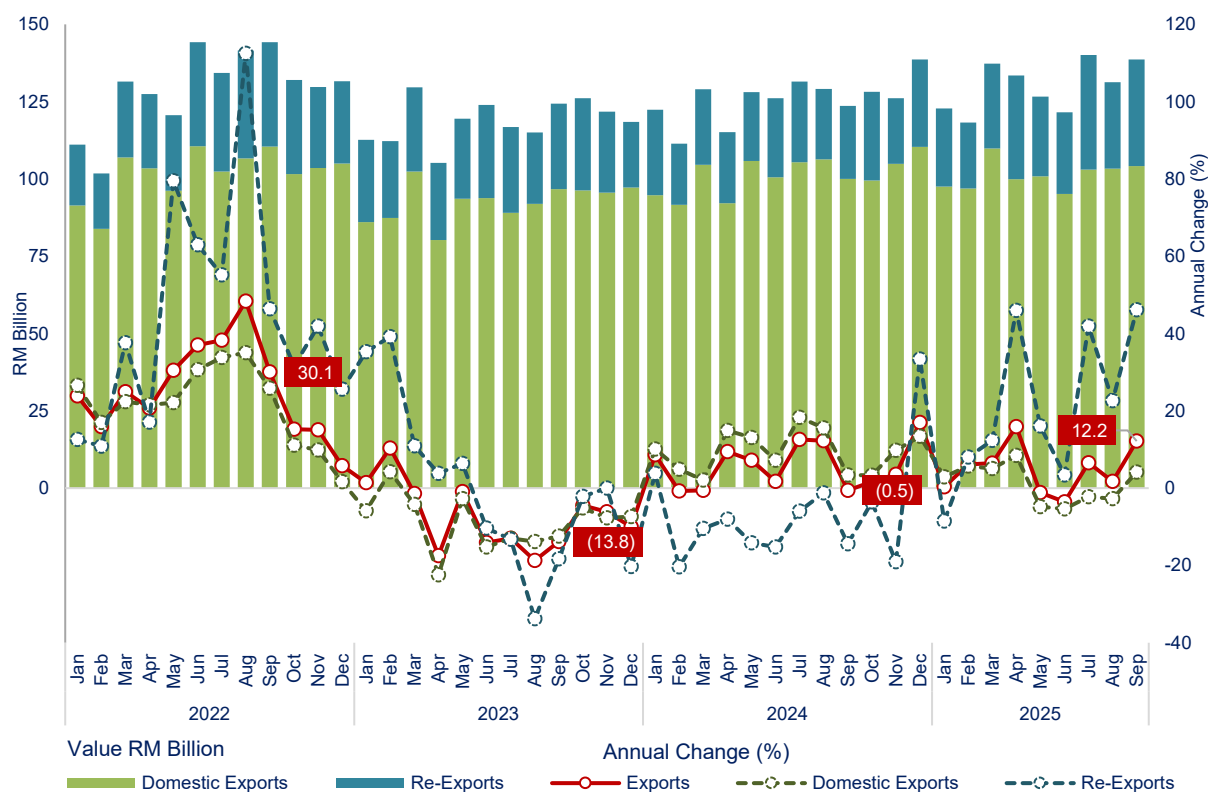
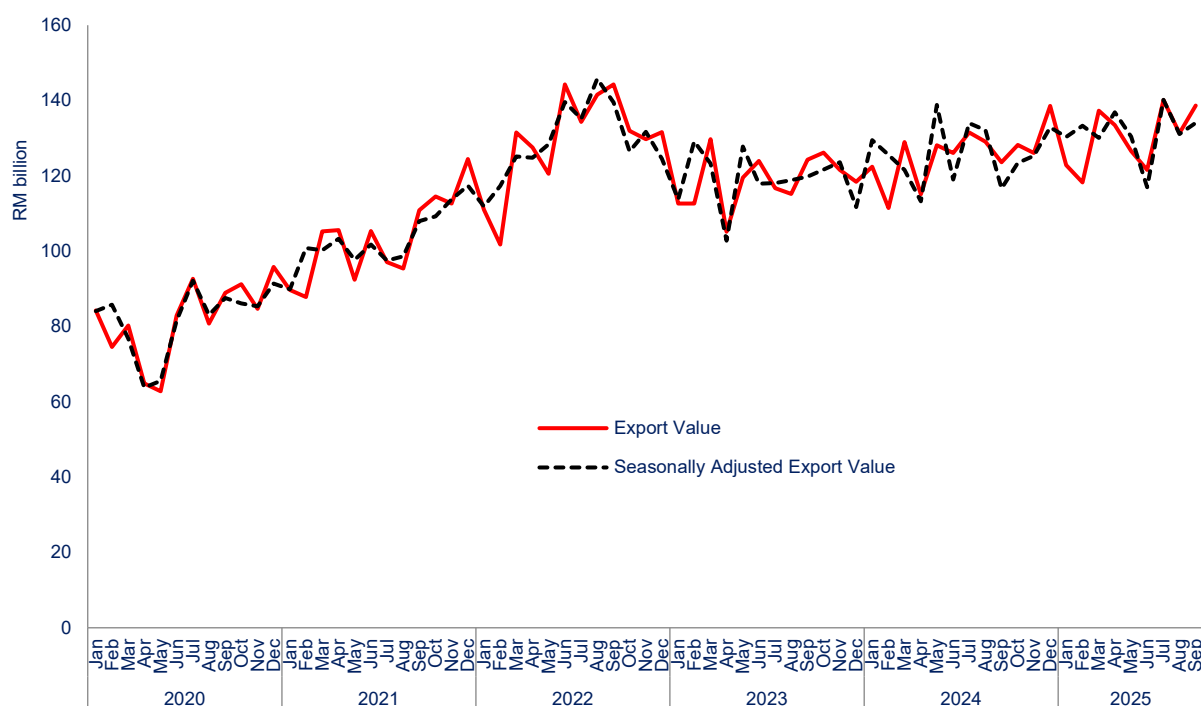


Chart 3: Actual Export Value and Seasonally Adjusted Export Value, RM billion



Export Performance for Major Country of Destination

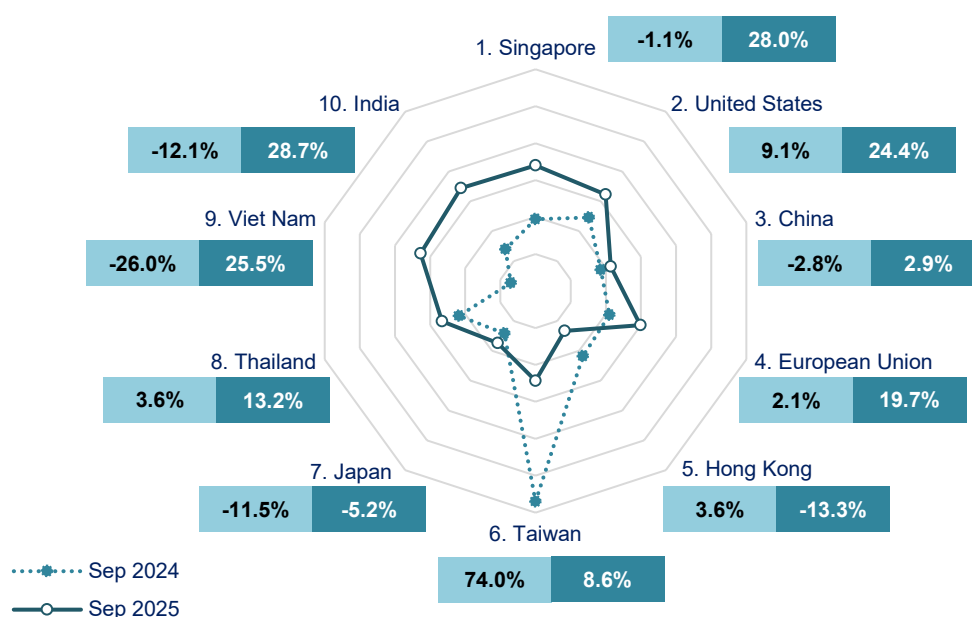
Singapore and the United States were Malaysia's top export destinations in September 2025 with a contribution of 31.3 per cent to total exports.

Exports to Singapore were valued at RM23.4 billion, representing 16.9 per cent of total exports, marking a 28.0 per cent increase or RM5.1 billion, y-o-y. This growth was primarily supported by higher exports of electrical & electronic (E&E) products (+RM4.8 billion, +54.6%), optical & scientific equipment (+RM103.5 million, +20.0%), crude petroleum (+RM93.2 million, +100.0%), machinery, equipment & parts (+RM70.8 million, +4.2%).

Meanwhile, exports to the United States, the second major country of destination in September 2025, amounted to RM20.1 billion and contributed 14.5 per cent to Malaysia total exports, increasing 24.4 per cent or RM3.9 billion, y-o-y. This expansion was driven by higher exports of E&E products (+RM2.4 billion, +23.3%); other manufactures (+RM422.4 million, +39.3%); iron & steel products (+RM409.7 million, +295.2%); optical & scientific equipment (+RM370.6 million, +40.6%); machinery, equipment & parts (+RM242.5 million, +40.8%); and processed food (+RM105.5 million, +61.6%).

Exports to the top ten destinations increased, except for Hong Kong and Japan.

Exports to ASEAN Countries

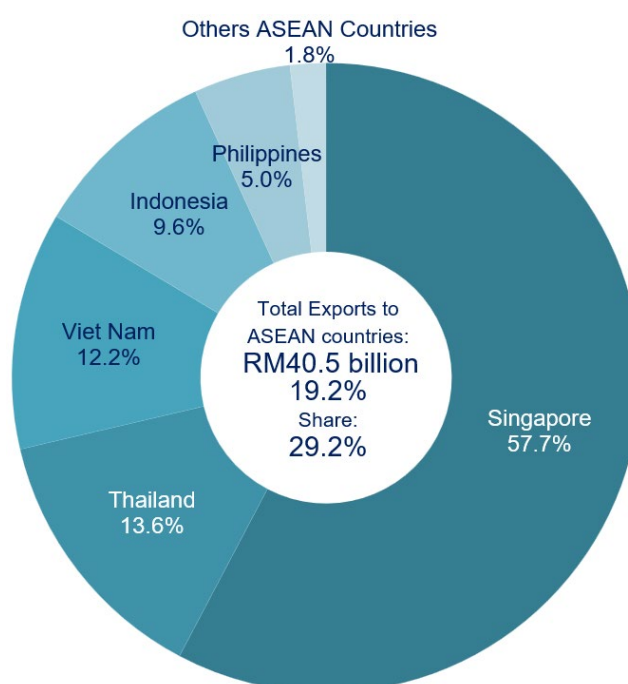
Exports to ASEAN countries represented 29.2 per cent of Malaysia total exports amounting to RM40.5 billion, an increase of 19.2 per cent compared to the same month in 2024.

This growth was mainly driven by higher exports of E&E products which increased by

50.3 per cent or RM6.4 billion, and optical & scientific products (+RM272.5 million, +33.3%).

Singapore remained the main destination, accounting for more than half of total exports to ASEAN (57.7%) with a value of RM23.4 billion, grew by 28.0 per cent compared to the previous year.

Chart 5: Percentage Share of Exports to ASEAN Countries, September 2025



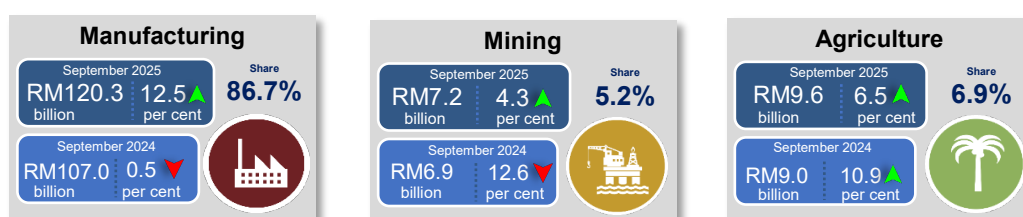
Export Performance for Economic Sectors

Exports of manufactured products increased by 12.5 per cent or RM13.3 billion in September 2025, accounting for 86.7 per cent of total exports. This growth was driven by higher exports of E&E products (+RM10.6 billion, +19.5%), followed by machinery, equipment & parts (+RM813.9 million, +14.7%), other manufactures (+RM809.8 million, +17.0%), optical & scientific products (+RM809.0 million, +16.7%), and palm oil-based manufactured products (+RM768.5 million, +27.4%).

Exports of mining products representing 5.2 per cent of total exports, rose by 4.3 per cent to RM7.2 billion, due to higher exports of metalliferous ores & metal scrap with an increase of RM988.8 million or 163.1 per cent.

Exports of agriculture products which made up 6.9 per cent of total exports showed an increased of 6.5 per cent to RM9.6 billion. The increase mainly driven by higher exports of palm oil & palm-based agriculture products (+RM587.6 million, +8.6%).

Exports of Selected Major Products

The strong export performance in September 2025 was mainly influenced by increases in the following products:

- E&E products covering 47.0 per cent of total exports, grew by 19.5 per cent, totalling RM54.5 billion in the previous year to RM65.1 billion;
- Palm oil & palm oil-based agriculture products (8.0% of total exports), rose by 14.0% or RM1.4 billion to RM11.0 billion. However, palm oil exports, the main commodity in this products group declined slightly by RM73.3 million or 1.3 per cent,
- Refined petroleum products, comprising 5.8 per cent of total exports, grew by 7.6 per cent or RM565.7 million to RM8.0 billion, in line with a rise in export volume 18.8 per cent, despite a 9.4 per cent drop in average unit value.

due to lower export volume (-7.1%). The price of local palm oil increased by 8.6 per cent to RM4,371.5 per metric tonnes; and

However, declines were recorded the following products:

- Liquefied natural gas (LNG) contributed 2.7 per cent of total exports, fell by RM563.5 million or 13.2 per cent to RM3.7 billion. This is due to a lower average unit value 17.2 per cent, though export volume rose 4.8 per cent;
- Crude petroleum which accounts for 1.0 per cent of total exports, dropped by RM298.4 million or 17.3 per cent to RM1.4 billion despite higher export volume (+2.9%). In tandem with the lower Brent oil price to RM286.2 per barrel generating a lower average unit value of 19.6 per cent;
- Timber & timber-based products declined by 5.5 per cent or RM100.3 million to RM1.7 billion, contributing 1.2 per cent to total exports; and
- Natural rubber which accounted for 0.2 per cent of exports, decreased by 16.2 per cent or RM51.0 million to RM264.2 million. This was in line with the reduction of export volume (-16.0%) and average unit value (-0.2%), aligned with lower SMR20 rubber prices (-9.6%).

Imports rebounded to a positive growth

Performance of Imports

Malaysia imports rebounded in September 2025, registering a 7.3 per cent increase or RM8.0 billion to reach RM118.8 billion. On a m-o-m basis, imports rose by 2.9 per cent or RM3.4 billion. With regards to analysis of the seasonally adjusted terms m-o-m, imports increased by 7.8 per cent to RM120.4 billion.

On a y-o-y basis, imports by End Use showed positive growth in capital goods (+9.3%) and consumption goods (+5.1%), but intermediate goods declined by 7.6 per cent.

Chart 6: Imports, Value (RM billion) and Annual Change (%)

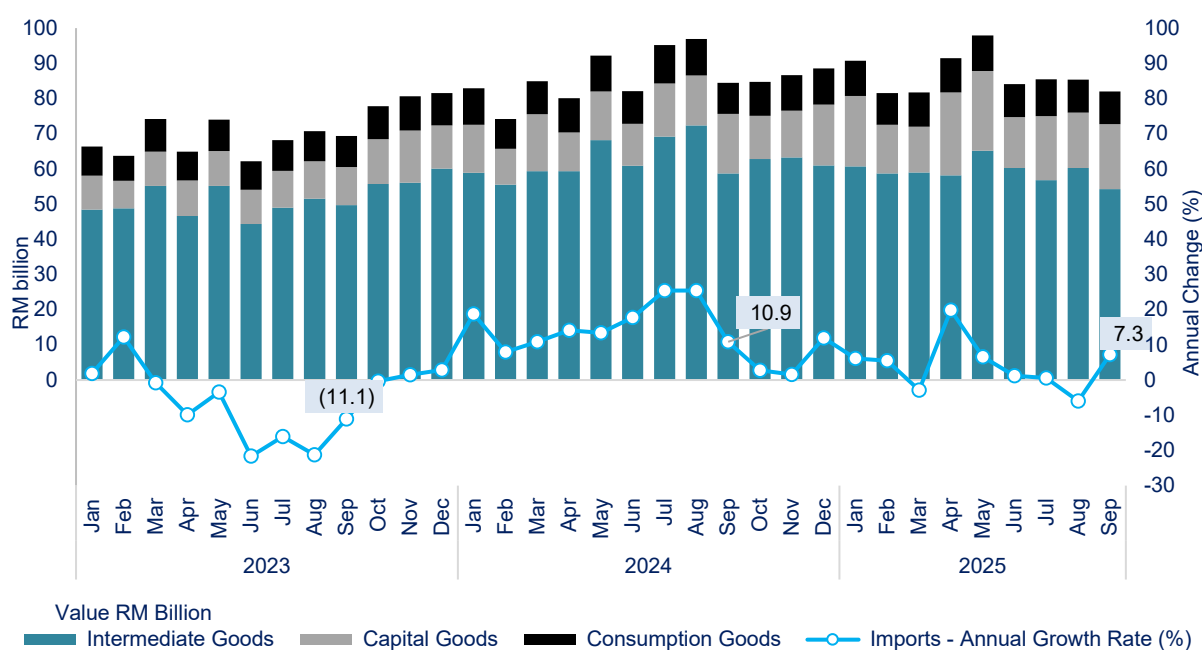
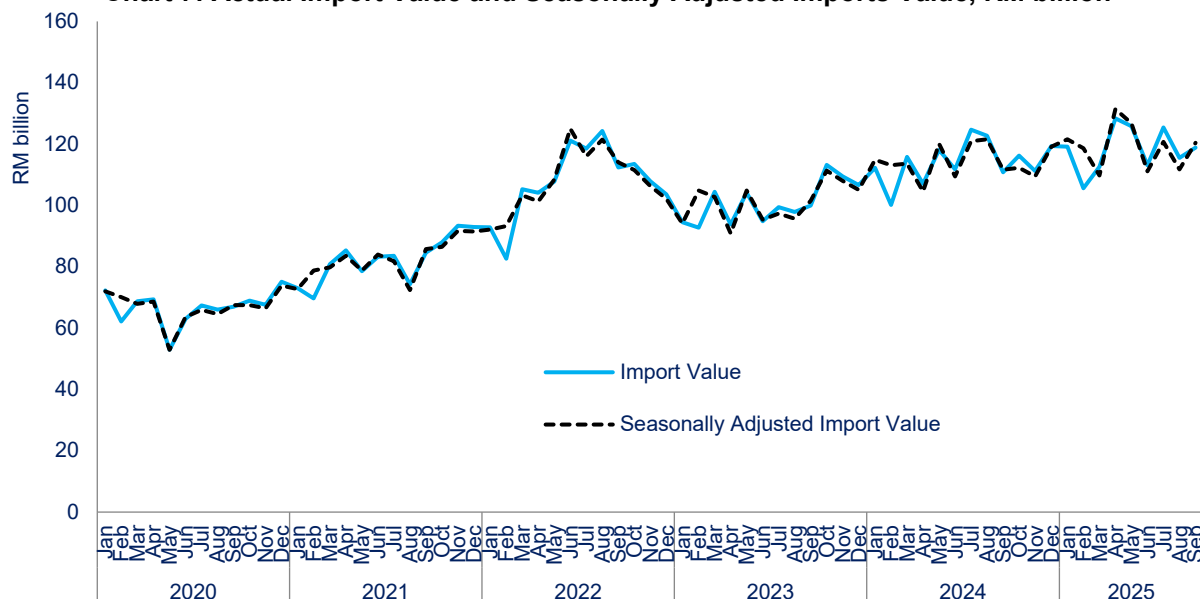


Chart 7: Actual Import Value and Seasonally Adjusted Imports Value, RM billion



Import Performance for Major Country of Origin

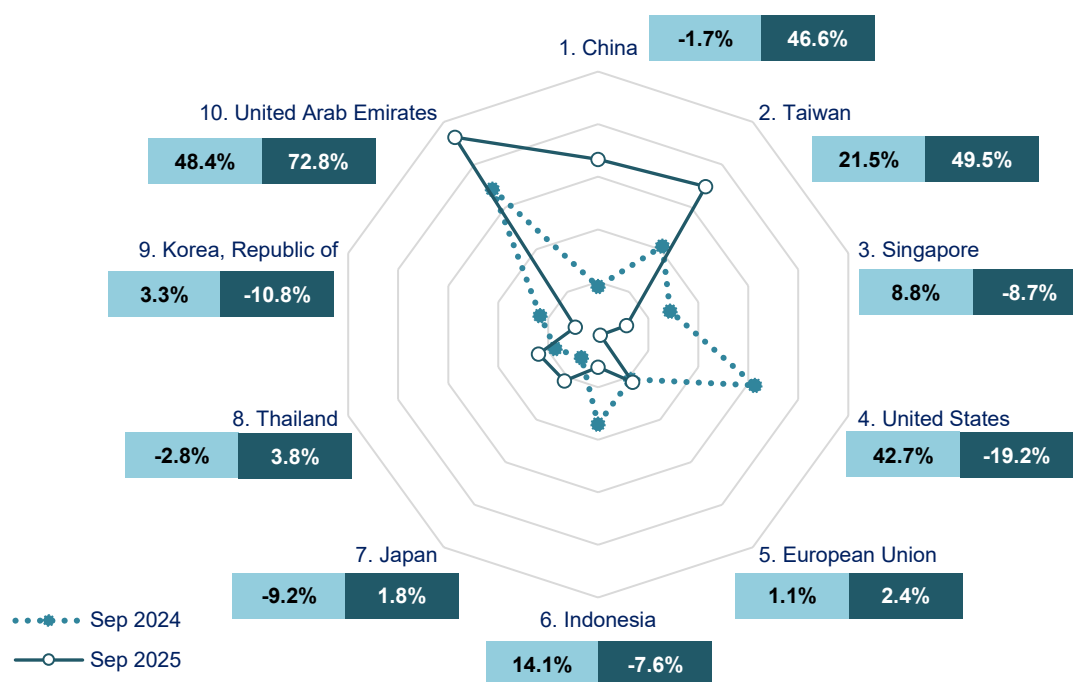
China and Taiwan were Malaysia's top major country of origin for imports in September 2025, contributing 36.7 per cent of total imports.

Imports from China represented 26.3 per cent of Malaysia's import, surged by 46.6 per cent to RM31.2 billion. The rise was driven by higher imports of E&E products with an increase 81.1 per cent or RM7.0 billion, followed by transport equipment (+RM472.0 million, +54.4%), other manufactures (+RM452.7 million, +72.5%), manufacture of metal (+RM318.7 million, +21.7%), chemicals & chemical products (+RM295.9 million, +18.2%), petroleum products (+RM259.5 million, +59.6%), and machinery, equipment & parts (+RM226.9 million, +7.8%).

Imports from Taiwan were valued at RM12.4 billion consist of 10.4 per cent of Malaysia's imports, rising 49.5 per cent or RM4.1 billion, y-o-y. The growth mainly due to higher imports of E&E products (+RM3.7 billion, +56.0%), other manufactures (+RM227.8 million, +498.7%), machinery, equipment & parts (+RM190.6 million, +123.9%), and petroleum products (+RM175.1 million, +30.1%).

The annual change in imports from the top ten major country of origin showed increases except from Singapore, the United States, Indonesia, and the Republic of Korea compared to the same period last year.

Chart 8: Annual Change for Imports for Major Country of Origin, September 2024 and September 2025



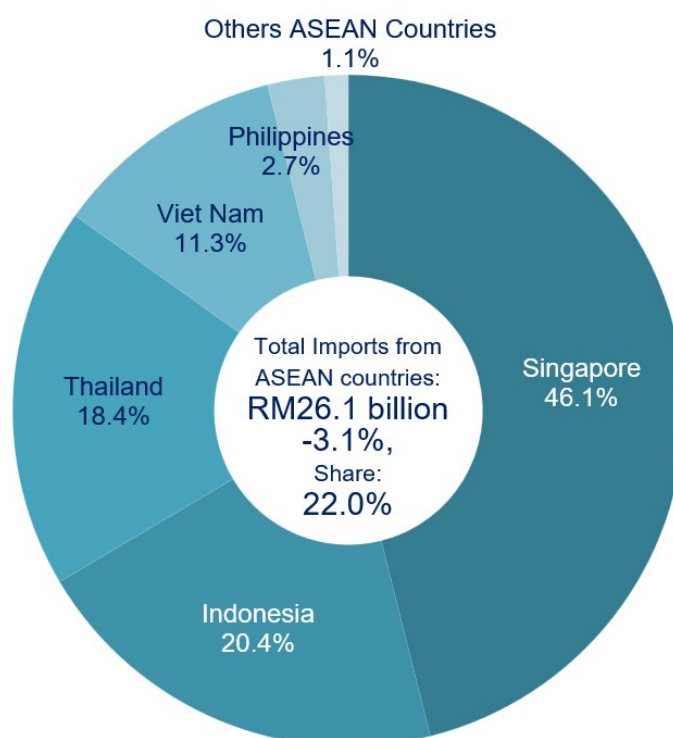
Imports from ASEAN Countries

Imports from ASEAN countries contracted by 3.1 per cent in September 2025 to RM26.1 billion, representing 22.0 per cent of Malaysia's total imports. The decline was mainly due to lower imports of petroleum products (-RM820.8 million, -18.9%) and

transport equipment (-RM498.3 million, -35.0%).

Among major ASEAN countries, decreases were observed in imports from Singapore, Indonesia, the Philippines, and Myanmar.

Import Performance for Economic Sectors

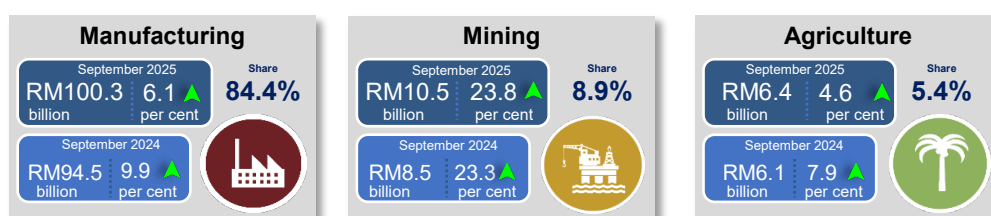
Manufactured products which made up 84.4 per cent of total imports, grew by 6.1 per cent from RM94.5 billion to RM100.3 billion, y-o-y. This performance was driven by higher imports of E&E products (+RM4.9 billion, +12.1%), machinery, equipment & parts (+RM973.0 million, +11.1%), and other manufactures (+RM961.1 million, +47.4%).

Imports of mining products totaled RM10.5 billion, up 23.8 per cent compared to the previous year and contributed 8.9 per cent of total Malaysia's

import. This growth was due to higher imports of crude petroleum (+RM1.8 billion, +37.0%) and metalliferous ores & metal scrap (+RM503.2 million, +52.3%).

Imports of agriculture products (5.4% of total imports) rose by 4.6 per cent or RM282.0 million to RM6.4 billion, supported by higher imports of palm oil & palm oil-based agriculture products (+RM614.5 million, +253.5%) and seafood, fresh, chilled or frozen (+RM26.7 million, +8.1%).

Imports of Selected Major Products

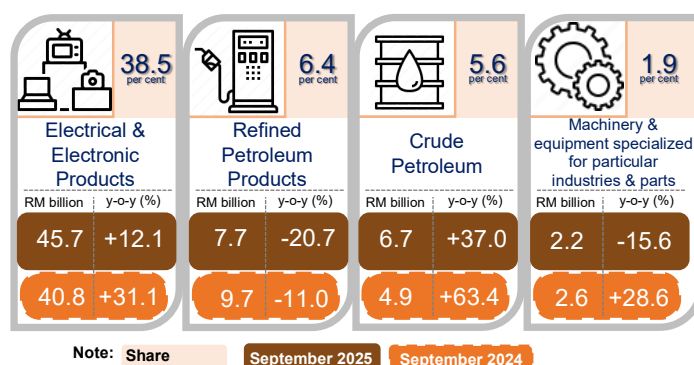
Import performance in September 2025 was encouraging, with positive growth recorded in following products:

- E&E products contributing 38.5 per cent of total imports, up RM4.9 billion or 12.1 per cent to RM45.7 billion; and
- Crude petroleum contributing 5.6 per cent of total imports, increased by RM1.8 billion or 37.0 per cent to RM6.7 billion, consistent with an increase in import volume (+55.9%). On the contrary, decrease in average unit value (-12.1%) and Brent oil prices (-9.6%) to RM286.2 per barrel.

However, declines were observed in the following products:

- Refined petroleum products contributing 6.4 per cent of total imports, down by RM2.0 billion or 20.7 per cent to RM7.7 billion, with lower import volume (-6.7%) and average unit value (-15.1%); and
- Machinery & equipment specialized for particular industries & parts contributing 1.9 per cent of total imports, fell by 15.6 per cent or RM411.3 million to RM2.2 billion.

Imports for End Use & Broad Economic Categories (BEC) Classification

Total imports in September 2025 amounted to RM118.8 billion, an increase of 7.3 per cent compared to the same month the preceding year. The three main End Use categories which representing 69.0 per cent of total imports were:

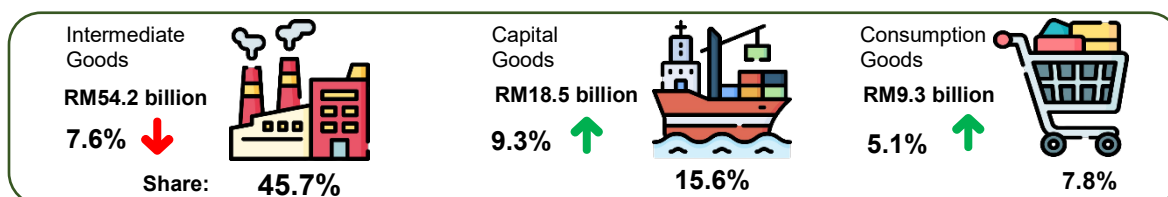
Intermediate goods, valued at RM54.2 billion or 45.7 of total imports, down 7.6 per cent due to lower imports of parts & accessories of capital goods (except transport equipment) (-RM3.6 billion, -19.3%) and fuel & lubricants, processed, other (-RM3.2 billion, -64.7%).

Capital goods, amounting to RM18.5 billion (15.6% of total imports) up 9.3 per cent, mainly due to higher imports of capital goods (except

transport equipment) (+RM1.0 billion, +6.4%) and transport equipment, industrial (+RM548.7 million, +67.8%).

Consumption goods, valued at RM9.3 billion (7.8% of total imports), increased 5.1 per cent, supported by higher imports of durables good (+RM360.4 million, +27.8%) and food & beverages, processed, mainly for household consumption (+RM232.1 million, +8.2%).

EXPORTS AND IMPORTS BY LOCATION

Malaysia's total trade for September 2025 amounted to RM257.5 billion with exports and imports recording RM138.7 billion and RM118.8 billion, respectively.

Exports was valued at RM138.7 billion in September 2025, increased RM15.1 billion (+12.2%) as compared to the same month of the previous year. The increase in exports was attributed to the higher exports in Pulau Pinang (+RM11.5 billion), Johor (+RM3.5 billion), Selangor (+RM662.0 million), Perak (+RM135.7 million), Sabah (+RM105.5 million), Negeri Sembilan (+RM99.1 million), Perlis (+RM5.7 million) and Melaka (+RM2.5 million). However, exports decreased in Kedah by RM515.3 million, Sarawak (-RM359.4 million), W.P. Labuan (-RM46.5 million), Pahang (-RM35.5 million), Terengganu (-RM15.2 million), W.P. Kuala Lumpur (-RM7.3 million) and Kelantan (-RM0.7 million).

Pulau Pinang remained as the top exporter with a contribution of 41.6 per cent, followed by Johor

(19.8%), Selangor (15.1%), Sarawak (5.6%) and W.P. Kuala Lumpur (3.7%).

At the same time, imports in September 2025 increased RM8.0 billion (+7.3%) as compared to the same month in year 2024. The increase in imports was attributed by the higher imports in most states such as W.P. Kuala Lumpur (+RM4.4 billion), Pulau Pinang (+RM2.2 billion), Johor (+RM2.0 billion), Perak (+RM342.8 million), Negeri Sembilan (+RM335.3 million), Sabah (+RM302.9 million), Sarawak (+RM201.6 million), Melaka (+RM117.9 million), Perlis (+RM37.4 million) and W.P. Labuan (+RM36.7 million). However, imports decreased in Selangor by RM739.2 million, Kedah (-RM656.2 million), Terengganu (-RM254.7 million), Pahang (-RM183.8 million) and Kelantan (-RM2.9 million).

Selangor dominates Malaysia's imports with a share of 25.1 per cent, followed by Johor (24.2%), Pulau Pinang (22.5%), W.P. Kuala Lumpur (10.3%) and Kedah (4.8%).

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NOTA TEKNIKAL

1. PENGENALAN

Penerbitan ini mengandungi Perangkaan Perdagangan Luar Negeri Malaysia (barangan) berkaitan dengan import dan eksport (termasuk eksport semula) mengikut seksyen dan Bahagian barangan, negara asal dan yang dituju, barangan utama / terpilih, Klasifikasi Kategori Ekonomi Umum (BEC) dan penggunaan akhir serta data pelarasan musim.

Statistik ini juga meliputi Perdagangan Luar Negeri Malaysia (barangan) berkaitan import dan eksport di peringkat negeri (mengikut pintu keluar dan masuk) dengan seluruh dunia.

2. OBJEKTIF

Objektif utama penerbitan ini untuk membekalkan statistik tentang prestasi perdagangan Malaysia dengan negara-negara lain dari segi nilai dan volum barangan. Penerbitan ini menjadi input kepada penggubalan dasar, rujukan penting dalam pelaksanaan keputusan, pemantauan dan penilaian keberkesanan program pembangunan negara serta penyelidikan.

3. BIDANG DAN LIPUTAN

3.1 Malaysia menggunakan 'sistem perdagangan umum' dalam penyusunan Perangkaan Perdagangan Luar Negeri. Di bawah sistem ini, sempadan negara digunakan sebagai sempadan perangkaan. Semua barang yang dibawa masuk atau keluar dari negara (selain pengecualian yang disebutkan di para 11 di bawah) direkodkan, sama ada barangan itu tertakluk kepada kelulusan tertentu atau pun tidak. Barangan yang dibawa masuk atau keluar dari gudang-gudang simpanan kastam, Zon Bebas direkodkan di dalam perangkaan ini.

3.2 Butir-butir tentang kapal dan kapal terbang dagangan dan persendirian turut **diambil kira** jika ianya diimport atau dieksport sebagai barang yang dibeli, dijual atau disewa (kewangan) tidak kira sama ada ianya tiba atau berlepas dengan kuasanya sendiri.

3.3 Eksport mengikut lokasi adalah berdasarkan negeri asal (iaitu negeri dalam Malaysia di mana peringkat akhir pengeluaran atau pembuatan berlaku). Sebaliknya, import mengikut lokasi berdasarkan negeri destinasi terakhir (iaitu negeri di mana barangan dikeluarkan daripada kawalan Kastam, tetapi tidak semestinya di mana barangan itu akhirnya dijual atau digunakan).

Ketepatan dalam pelaporan negeri asal dan negeri destinasi akhir dalam dokumentasi oleh pihak Jabatan Kastam Diraja Malaysia (JKDM) memberi kesan kepada kualiti statistik perdagangan barangan mengikut lokasi. Dalam hal ini, lokasi pemuatan/pelepasan akan digunakan sebagai proksi bagi negeri asal/destinasi akhir yang sebenar.

3.4 Aktiviti eksport dan import yang berlaku di kawasan Supra (merangkumi aktiviti pengeluaran yang melangkaui pusat kepentingan ekonomi utama bagi mana- mana negeri) atau periklanan yang dilakukan oleh ejen penghantar tidak termasuk dalam penyusunan statistik import dan eksport mengikut lokasi. Nilai import atau eksport bagi W.P. Kuala Lumpur adalah termasuk W.P. Putrajaya.

4. SUMBER DATA

- 4.3 Penyata dan pengikraran eksport mengenai *bunkers* dan *stores* yang dibekalkan kepada kapal terbang yang dikeluarkan/diluluskan oleh syarikat-syarikat petroleum.
- 4.4 Penyata penjualan barangan yang dibekalkan oleh pengusaha-pengusaha kedai bebas cukai.
- 4.5 Penyata jualan dan belian elektrik yang dikeluarkan oleh syarikat pengeluar

5. KONSEP DAN DEFINISI

- 5.1 Penyusunan statistik ini selaras dengan garis panduan dalam **International Merchandise Trade Statistics: Concepts and Definitions (IMTS) 2010** daripada Pertubuhan Bangsa-Bangsa Bersatu.

5.2 Import

Sesuatu barangan dianggap sebagai import apabila ianya dibawa **masuk** ke dalam negara, sama ada terus ataupun disimpan di gudang dalam kawasan yang dikawalselia oleh pihak Kastam tanpa mengira sama ada barangan tersebut adalah untuk kegunaan sendiri, diproses, digunakan dalam pembuatan ataupun untuk dieksport semula ke negara lain.

5.3 Eksport

Sesuatu barangan (keluaran atau buatan tempatan atau diimport untuk dieksport semula) dianggap sebagai eksport apabila ianya dibawa **keluar** dari negara.

5.4 Eksport Domestik

Sesuatu barangan (keluaran atau buatan tempatan) dianggap sebagai eksport domestik apabila ianya dibawa **keluar** dari negara.

5.5 Eksport Semula

Sesuatu barangan dianggap sebagai eksport semula apabila ianya dibawa **keluar** dari negara dalam keadaan seperti mana ianya **diimport** tanpa mengalami sebarang **perubahan**. Proses membungkus semula, menyisih atau menggred tidak dikira sebagai satu proses perubahan.

5.6 Imbangan Perdagangan

Imbangan perdagangan ialah perbezaan antara nilai eksport dan import. Apabila eksport melebihi import **lebih** direkodkan manakala **defisit** pula dicatatkan apabila import melebihi eksport.

6. ASAS PENILAIAN

- 6.1 **WTO Valuation Agreement (1994)** digunakan sebagai asas penilaian untuk semua transaksi barangan.
- 6.2 **Nilai** ditunjukkan dalam Ringgit Malaysia.
- 6.3 **Import** dinilai mengikut **cif (cost, insurance and freight – kos, insuran dan tambang)** iaitu nilai barangan di pasaran di sempadan statistik/kastam negara pengimport termasuk semua perbelanjaan insuran dan tambang semasa dalam perjalanan **tetapi** kos pemunggahan dari alat pengangkutan tidak diambil kira **kecuali** kos tersebut ditanggung sendiri oleh pengangkut.
- 6.4 **Eksport** dinilai mengikut **fob (free on board)** iaitu nilai barangan di pasaran di sempadan statistik/kastam negara pengeksport termasuk semua perbelanjaan pengangkutan ke sempadan tersebut, duti eksport dan duti lain yang perlu dibayar serta kos untuk memunggah barang ke atas alat pengangkutan **kecuali** kos terakhir itu ditanggung sendiri oleh pengangkut.

7. KLASIFIKASI BARANG DAGANGAN

- 7.1 Penyusunan Perangkaan Perdagangan Luar Negeri (barangan) bagi bulan rujukan Januari 2022 hingga Mei 2022 menggunakan Harmonised Commodity Description and Coding System (HS) 2017 yang juga dikenali sebagai Perintah Duti Kastam (PDK) 2017. Bermula bulan rujukan Jun 2022, HS2022 yang juga dikenali sebagai PDK2022 telah digunakan menggantikan HS2017. Walau bagaimanapun, pengelasan mengikut Standard International Trade Classification (S.I.T.C) Rev.4 masih digunakan dengan penyesuaian.
- 7.2 Selepas perbincangan dan perundingan dengan Lembaga Minyak Sawit Malaysia (MPOB), pilihan kod untuk minyak kelapa sawit dan hasil keluaran berasaskan minyak kelapa sawit adalah berdasarkan minyak kelapa sawit tulen dan hasil keluaran berasaskan minyak kelapa sawit serta kod-kod yang berasaskan minyak kelapa sawit dan hasil keluaran berasaskan minyak kelapa sawit (melebihi 50%).

8. VOLUM

Volum merupakan berat bersih atau ukuran lain bagi barangan itu, tidak termasuk kontena. Jika barangan itu dilaporkan dalam pelbagai unit ukuran, maka unit ukuran tersebut tidak dapat diselaraskan. Oleh itu, hanya nilai barangan sahaja dipaparkan.

9. NEGARA ASAL DAN YANG DITUJU

- 9.1 **Negara asal** merujuk kepada lokasi / negara barangan yang dibawa masuk ke dalam negara. Jika maklumat negara asalnya tidak dapat ditentukan. Sebagai contoh, bagi barangan melalui Singapura, maka import berkenaan dilaporkan dari Singapura.
- 9.2 **Negara yang dituju** merujuk kepada destinasi/negara akhir barangan itu dijangka akan digunakan. Bagi barangan yang dihantar dengan *optional bill of lading*, negara di mana pelabuhan pertama diketahui akan dilaporkan sebagai negara yang dituju. Jika maklumat negara yang dituju tidak dapat ditentukan. Sebagai contoh, bagi

barangan yang dieksport melalui Singapura, maka eksport berkenaan dilaporkan ke Singapura.

- 9.3 **Bagi bunkers dan stores yang dibekalkan kepada kapal dan kapal terbang,** negara yang dituju ditentukan mengikut lokasi/negara residen syarikat pengendali kapal atau kapal terbang tersebut.

10. TRANSAKSI BERNILAI RENDAH (TBR)

Mulai bulan rujukan Januari 2023, transaksi tunggal 'di bawah RM1,000' bagi Semenanjung Malaysia telah diliputi dalam penyusunan Perangkaan Perdagangan Luar Negeri dan transaksi bernilai 'di bawah RM5,000' telah dilaporkan mengikut kod HS yang diikrar. Manakala mulai bulan rujukan Januari 2024, transaksi tunggal 'di bawah RM2,000' untuk Sabah dan Sarawak telah dilaporkan mengikut kod HS yang diikrar.

11. PENGECEUALIAN

Barang-barang yang tidak termasuk dalam Perangkaan Perdagangan Luar Negeri adalah:

- 11.1 barangan transit, iaitu pengangkutan barangan di bawah kawalan kastam dari sebuah stesen kastam ke sebuah stesen kastam yang lain. Misalnya, pergerakan barangan dari Thailand ke Singapura melalui Semenanjung Malaysia dan pergerakan barangan dari sebuah zon bebas ke sebuah zon bebas yang lain di Malaysia. Barang dalam transit yang diliputi *through bills of lading* / *air-way bills* juga termasuk di bawah kategori ini;
- 11.2 barangan pindah kapal, iaitu pemindahan barangan di bawah kawalan pihak yang berkuasa, dari suatu pengangkutan yang digunakan untuk pengimportan kepada suatu pengangkutan lain yang digunakan untuk pengeksportan **dalam** kawasan kawalan pihak berkuasa yang sama. Stesen ini merupakan stesen pengimportan dan juga pengeksportan. Sebagai contoh, barangan dari Myanmar yang dibawa masuk ke kawasan kastam Pulau Pinang yang semata-mata bertujuan untuk dihantar ke negara ketiga (misalnya ke Hong Kong). Satu lagi contoh adalah barangan dari India yang dibawa masuk melalui Kawasan Bebas Pelabuhan Klang yang semata-mata bertujuan untuk dihantar ke Negara Ketiga (misalnya ke Sepanyol);
- 11.3 emas (kewangan) dan wang kertas serta duit syiling dalam edaran;
- 11.4 barangan yang diimport dan dieksport oleh, atau bagi pihak perkhidmatan diplomatik dan Angkatan Tentera Bukan Malaysia;
- 11.5 filem wayang untuk disewa;
- 11.6 kemasukan barangan untuk sementara waktu dan ianya tertakluk kepada pengeksportan semula dalam keadaan yang sama. Barangan ini diimport untuk tujuan tertentu dan dieksport semula dalam masa yang telah ditentukan tanpa mengalami sebarang perubahan, kecuali susut nilai yang biasa. Contohnya, binatang dan motokar bagi pertunjukan sarkas, perlumbaan, pertandingan dan pameran serta peralatan-peralatan bunyi untuk pertunjukan muzikal;
- 11.7 *barges (lash)* yang digunakan untuk mengangkut kargo dari kapal ke pantai atau sebaliknya;

- 11.8 ikan dan hasil laut lain yang dibawa oleh kapal laut berdaftar di Malaysia dan mendarat terus dari laut.
- 11.9 bekas untuk menyimpan sesuatu barang/benda, silinder, botol dan seumpamanya yang dinyatakan sebagai 'dikembalikan';
- 11.10 bekalan dan minyak yang dibekalkan kepada kapal laut dan kapal terbang yang dikendalikan oleh operator yang menetap di Malaysia;
- 11.11 semua sampel, pemberian dan bahan untuk ujian atau analisa tanpa mengira nilai transaksi yang terlibat;
- 11.12 tiket loteri & toto;
- 11.13 pergerakan barangan di antara Negeri di dalam Semenanjung Malaysia tanpa mengira cara pengangkutan serta pergerakan barangan melalui **darat** di antara Sabah dan Sarawak;
- 11.14 disket atau CD-ROM yang mengandungi perisian komputer dan / atau data, dibuat mengikut pesanan, audio dan videotapes yang mengandungi perakaman asal dan customised blueprints, dll; dan
- 11.15 barangan untuk **dibaiki**.

12. KEMASKINI TERHADAP NEGARA-NEGARA KESATUAN EROPAH (EU)

Bermula 1 Februari 2020, United Kingdom secara rasminya keluar daripada EU. Perkembangan ini telah diambil kira di dalam penerbitan mulai bulan Februari 2020 dan seterusnya.

- 13. Bermula rujukan Januari 2022, Statistik Eksport Produk Halal mengikut Pengelasan Barangan disusun daripada hasil gabungan pangkalan data Perdagangan Luar Negeri dengan senarai syarikat berstatus halal yang diperolehi daripada Jabatan Kemajuan Islam Malaysia (JAKIM).

14. PELARASAN MUSIM

Data siri masa adalah amat berguna untuk ahli ekonomi, pembuat dasar dan polisi serta penganalisis siri masa untuk mengenal pasti ciri-ciri penting siri ekonomi seperti arah, *turning point* dan konsistensi antara penunjuk ekonomi yang lain. Kadang-kadang ciri ini sukar untuk diperhatikan kerana pergerakan bermusim. Oleh itu, sekiranya kesan bermusim boleh disingkirkan, perilaku data siri ini dapat dilihat dengan lebih baik. Anggaran dan penyingkiran kesan bermusim dipanggil pelarasan bermusim.

Pelarasan bermusim adalah satu proses untuk mengenal pasti dan menyingkirkan bentuk pola bermusim yang biasa berlaku dalam tempoh satu tahun, yang mungkin juga merangkumi pengaruh dari kesan cuti yang bergerak dan hari bekerja/ berdagang bagi suatu tempoh. Objektif utama proses ini adalah untuk menyerlahkan dasar arah aliran dan pergerakan-pergerakan jangka pendek dalam siri ini.

Di Malaysia, kebanyakan data siri masa terjejas oleh kesan bermusim. Oleh itu, untuk menghapuskan kesan bermusim dan juga melaraskan musim data siri masa ekonomi Malaysia, pakej pelarasan bermusim standard, X-12 ARIMA telah digunakan oleh Jabatan Perangkaan, Malaysia.

Data siri masa ekonomi Malaysia kerap dipengaruhi oleh perayaan agama utama seperti Aidilfitri bagi umat Islam, Tahun Baru Cina untuk kaum Cina dan Deepavali untuk kaum India. Tarikh perayaan-perayaan ini tetap mengikut tahun lunar tetapi berbeza-beza mengikut kalendar Gregorian. Oleh itu, untuk menganggar dan menyingkirkan kesan cuti yang bergerak dari data siri masa, satu prosedur telah dibangunkan iaitu *Seasonal Adjustment for Malaysia* (SEAM).

Kaedah SEAM digunakan untuk membuang kesan bermusim bagi data Perdagangan Luar Negeri Malaysia. Pelarasan musim dibuat ke atas data bulanan bagi jumlah eksport dan import. Data siri pelarasan bermusim untuk tiga tahun sebelumnya akan disemak setiap tahun apabila data untuk 12 bulan lengkap.

15. KLASIFIKASI MENGIKUT KATEGORI EKONOMI UMUM (BEC)

- 15.1 Klasifikasi mengikut Kategori Ekonomi Umum (BEC) diwujudkan adalah untuk meringkaskan Perangkaan Perdagangan Luar Negeri (PPLN) mengikut kelas komoditi ekonomi yang luas. Di samping itu, ia dibentuk sebagai pengantara untuk menukarkan data PPLN yang disusun berdasarkan HS kepada kategori penggunaan akhir yang lebih bermakna dalam konteks Sistem Akaun Negara (SNA) iaitu barang modal, barang pengantara dan barang penggunaan. Penyusunan ini membolehkan data PPLN dihubungkan dengan perangkaan ekonomi umum seperti perangkaan akaun negara dan perangkaan perindustrian bagi tujuan penganalisan ekonomi di peringkat negara, kawasan dan dunia.
- 15.2 BEC termasuk sembilan belas kategori asas. Setiap kategori BEC didefinisikan dari segi bahagian, kumpulan, sub-kumpulan dan tajuk HS. Setiap tajuk asas HS ditetapkan secara khusus kepada satu kategori BEC. Penetapan ini dibuat berasaskan penggunaan akhir yang utama bagi sesuatu komoditi dalam setiap tajuk HS, walaupun erdapat banyak komoditi yang didagangkan di peringkat antarabangsa boleh dikelaskan kepada pelbagai kegunaan.
- 15.3 Statistik dalam Jadual 16: Import Barangan Mengikut Klasifikasi Kategori Ekonomi Umum dijana berdasarkan import tertangguh iaitu import tolak eksport semula. Angka tersebut boleh menjadi negatif bagi bulan rujukan tertentu jika eksport semula melebihi daripada import.

16. KERAHSIAAN DATA

Data perdagangan telah disusun di bawah peruntukan ***Statistics Act 1965 (Revised-1989)***. Akta ini mensyaratkan bahawa kandungan penyata individu adalah sulit. Selaras dengan peruntukan tersebut, hanya angka agregat diterbitkan.

17. DASAR PINDAAN

Data pada bulan semasa adalah sementara (provisional) dan tertakluk kepada pindaan sehingga ia dimuktamadkan. Pindaan dibuat sekiranya wujud maklumat tambahan. Bermula tahun 2021, data muktamad akan dikeluarkan 7 (tujuh) bulan selepas tahun rujukan. Perangkaan muktamad perdagangan luar negeri bagi tahun rujukan 2021 telah digunakan mulai bulan rujukan Jun 2022.

18. **PEMBUNDARAN**

Jumlah-jumlah kecil, apabila dicampurkan, **mungkin** tidak bersamaan dengan jumlah besar disebabkan oleh pembundaran.

TECHNICAL NOTES

1. INTRODUCTION

This publication contains statistics of Malaysia's External trade (merchandise) pertaining to imports and exports (including re-exports) by sections, divisions and groups of commodity, country of origin and destination, selected/major commodities, Broad Economic Category (BEC) classification and end-use as well as seasonally adjusted data.

This publication also contains statistics of Malaysia's External Trade (merchandise) on imports and exports at the state level (based on exit and entry points) with the rest of the world.

2. OBJECTIVE

The main objective of compiling Malaysia's external trade statistics is to provide information on Malaysia's trade performance vis-a-vis the rest of the world in terms of volume and value of merchandise goods. The trade statistics, therefore, serve as a tool in assisting the government in formulating policies and monitoring economic performance as well as for development planning. The data can also be used by the private sector and individuals for specific purposes such as for economic projection and analysis.

3. SCOPE AND COVERAGE

3.1 *The 'general trade system' of recording is adopted in compiling Malaysian external trade statistics. Under this system, the national boundary of the country is used as the statistical frontier. All goods entering or leaving the country (except specific exclusions mentioned in paragraph 11 below) are recorded, whether or not such goods are subject to clearance. Accordingly, goods entering or leaving customs bonded warehouses, Free Zones are recorded in the statistics.*

3.2 *Details of commercial and private ships and aircraft are also **included** in these statistics if they were imported or exported as goods purchased, sold or leased (financial) whether or not they arrived or departed under their own power.*

3.3 *Exports by location based on the state of origin (i.e. state of Malaysia where the final stage of production or manufacturing occurs). On the other hand, imports by location based on the state of final destination (i.e. the state of Malaysia in which goods are released from Customs controls, but not necessarily where they are ultimately sold or consumed).*

The accuracy in reporting the actual State of origin and State of final destination on Royal Malaysian Customs Department documentation affects the quality of State merchandise trade statistics. In this case, the location of loading/discharge may be used as a proxy for the actual state of origin/final destination.

3.4 *Export and import activities that are taking place in the Supra area (including production activities beyond the centre of predominant economic interest for any state) or declarations made by the agent are not included in the compilation of imports and exports statistics by location. Imports or exports value for the W.P. Kuala Lumpur includes the W.P. Putrajaya.*

4. SOURCE OF DATA

- 4.1 *Import and export declarations (hard/soft copy) approved by the Royal Malaysian Customs Department (RMCD) and Free Zone Authorities.*
- 4.2 *Particulars on postal/courier packages are provided by Pos Malaysia Berhad.*
- 4.3 *Statements and export declarations on bunkers and stores supplied to aircraft issued/approved by the petroleum companies.*
- 4.4 *Statements on goods sold are supplied by the operators of duty-free shops.*
- 4.5 *Statements on the sale and purchase of electricity issued by 'power producer company'.*

5. CONCEPTS AND DEFINITIONS

- 5.1 *The compilation of these statistics is in accordance with the guidelines of the **International Merchandise Trade Statistics: Concepts and Definitions (IMTS) 2010** from the **United Nations**.*

5.2 **Imports**

*Goods are regarded as imports when they are brought **into** the country either directly or into bonded warehouses, irrespective of whether such goods are for consumption, to be processed, use in manufacturing or subsequent re-exports to other countries.*

5.3 **Exports**

*Goods (locally produced or manufactured or imported for subsequent re-exports) are regarded as exports when they are taken **out** of the country.*

5.4 **Domestic Exports**

*Goods (locally produced or manufactured) are regarded as domestic exports when they are taken **out** of the country.*

5.5 **Re-exports**

*Goods are regarded as re-exports when they are taken **out** of the country in the same form as they were **imported** without any **transformation**. Re-packing, sorting or grading processes are not considered as part of the transformation process.*

5.6 **Balance of Trade**

*The balance of trade is the difference between the value of exports and imports. When exports exceed imports it is recorded as a **surplus** while a **deficit** is registered when imports exceed exports.*

6. BASIS OF VALUATION

- 6.1 *The **WTO Valuation Agreement (1994)** is used as the basis of valuation for all transactions of goods.*
- 6.2 ***Values** are shown in Malaysian Ringgit.*

- 6.3 **Imports** are valued on a **c.i.f. (cost, insurance and freight)** basis, that is, the value of the goods in the market at the statistical / customs frontier of the importing country, including all charges for transport and insurance whilst in transit **but** excluding the cost of unloading from the carrier **unless** it is borne by the carrier.
- 6.4 **Exports** are valued on a **f.o.b. (free on board)** basis, that is, the value of the goods in the market at the statistical / customs frontier of the exporting country, including all costs of transporting the goods to the statistical / customs frontier, export and other duties payable as well as the cost of loading the goods onto the carrier **unless** the latter cost is borne by the carrier.

7. CLASSIFICATION OF COMMODITIES

- 7.1 The compilation of External Trade Statistics (merchandise) for the reference month of January 2022 to May 2022 used the Harmonised Commodity description and Coding system (HS) 2017, also known as Customs Duties Order (PDK) 2017. Commencing from the reference month of June 2022, HS2022 also known as PDK2022 has been used to replace HS2017. However, Standard International Trade Classification (S.I.T.C) Rev.4 is still in use with appropriate updates.
- 7.2 After discussion and consultation with Malaysian Palm Oil Board (MPOB), the selection of codes for palm oil and palm oil-based products is based on pure palm oil and palm oil-based products as well as those codes which are predominantly palm oil and palm oil-based products (more than 50%).

8. VOLUME

Volume, where shown, represent the nett weight or other measurement of the goods exclusive of packing containers. Where a commodity item comprises different kinds of commodities for which a common unit of measurement cannot be used, only values are shown.

9. COUNTRY OF ORIGIN AND DESTINATION

- 9.1 **Country of origin** refers to the location/country of goods brought into the country. If the country of origin information cannot be determined, for example, for goods via Singapore, then the import is reported from Singapore.
- 9.2 **Country of destination** refers to the final destination/country where the goods are expected to be used. For goods sent with a country where the first port is known will be reported as the country of destination. if the destination country information cannot be determined, for example, for goods exported through Singapore, then the exports is reported to Singapore.
- 9.3 **For bunkers and stores supplied to ships and aircraft**, the country of destination is determined according to the country of residence of the operator of the ship or aircraft.

10. LOW VALUE TRANSACTIONS (LVT)

With effect from reference month of January 2023, single transactions with a value 'below RM1,000' for Peninsular Malaysia have been covered in the compilation of External Trade Statistics and transactions worth 'below RM5,000' have been reported according to the pledged HS code. Meanwhile with effect from reference month of January 2024, single transactions with a value 'below RM2,000' for Sabah and Sarawak have been reported according to the pledged HS code.

11. EXCLUSIONS

Classes of goods excluded from external trade statistics are: -

- 11.1 transit cargo, that is goods transported under customs control from one Customs office to another. Examples are the movement of goods from Thailand bound for Singapore through Peninsular Malaysia and the movement of goods within Malaysia from one free trade zone to another. All goods in transit covered through bills of lading/air-way bills are also included in this category;*
- 11.2 transshipment cargo, that is goods transferred under the control of the relevant authorities from the importing means of transport to the exporting means of transport **within** the area of control of the same authorities, which is the office of both importation and exportation. For example, goods from Myanmar brought into the Pulau Pinang Customs area for the sole purpose of transport to a third country (e.g. to Hong Kong). Another example is goods from India brought into the Port Klang Free Zone for the sole purpose of transport to a third country (e.g. to Spain);*
- 11.3 gold bullion (monetary) and issued currency notes and coins;*
- 11.4 goods imported and exported by, or on behalf of, diplomatic services and non-Malaysian Armed Forces;*
- 11.5 exposed cinematographic films on a rental basis;*
- 11.6 temporary admission of goods subject to re-exportation in the same state. Such goods must be imported for a specific purpose and must be intended for re-exportation within a specified period without having undergone any change except normal depreciation. Examples are animals and cars for circuses, races, competitions and exhibitions and instruments/sound equipment for musical performances;*
- 11.7 barges (lash) used for the transportation of cargo from vessel to shore or vice-versa;*
- 11.8 fish and other marine produce landed by Malaysian registered vessels direct from the sea;*
- 11.9 containers, cylinders, bottles, crates and the like specified as returnable;*
- 11.10 stores and fuel supplied to ships and aircraft handled by operators of Malaysian residence;*
- 11.11 samples, gifts and specimens for test or analysis, irrespective of value;*
- 11.12 toto & lottery tickets;*

11.13 movement of goods by any mode of transportation between states within Peninsular Malaysia and movement of goods by **land** between Sabah and Sarawak;

11.14 diskettes or CD-ROMs with stored computer software and/or data, developed to order, audio and videotapes containing original recordings and customised blueprints, etc; and

11.15 goods for **repair**.

12. **UPDATE TO EUROPEAN UNION (EU) COUNTRIES**

From 1st July 2013, Croatia has joined EU. This development has been incorporated in the publication from July 2013 onwards.

13. *Commencing from January 2022, statistics on Exports of Halal Products by Commodity Classification is compiled from an integrated external trade database with list of Halal certified companies which obtained from the Department of Islamic Development Malaysia (JAKIM).*

14. **SEASONAL ADJUSTMENT**

Time-series data are very useful for economists, policy & decision makers and time-series analysts to identify the important features of economic series such as direction, turning point and consistency between other economic indicators. Sometimes this feature is difficult to observe because of seasonal movements. Thus, if the seasonal effect can be removed, the behaviour of the series would be better viewed. The estimation and removal of the seasonal effects is called seasonal adjustment.

Seasonal adjustment is a process to identify and to remove the regular within-a-year seasonal pattern, which may also include the influences of moving holidays and working / trading days effect in each period. The ultimate objective of the process is to highlight the underlying trends and short-term movements in the series.

In Malaysia, most of the time series data are affected by seasonal effects. Hence, to eliminate the seasonal effect as well as to seasonally adjust the Malaysian economic time series data, a standard seasonal adjustment package, X-12 ARIMA was used by Department of Statistics, Malaysia.

Malaysian economic time series data are often affected by major religious festivals such as Eid-ul Fitr of the Muslims, Chinese New Year of the Chinese and Deepavali of the Indians. These festivals' dates are fixed according to the lunar year but vary according to the Gregorian calendar. Therefore, to estimate and remove moving holiday effect from time-series data, a procedure was developed, namely Seasonal Adjustment for Malaysia (SEAM).

The SEAM method is used to remove seasonal effect for Malaysia's merchandise external trade data. The seasonal adjustment is carried out on monthly total exports and total imports. The seasonally adjusted series data for the preceding three years are revised each year when the figures for complete 12 months become available.

15. CLASSIFICATION BY BROAD ECONOMIC CATEGORIES (BEC)

- 15.1 *The BEC was originally devised mainly for the summarization of data on international trade by large economic classes of commodities. In addition, it was designed to serve as a means for converting external trade data compiled on the HS into end use categories that are meaningful within the framework of the System of National Accounts (SNA) namely capital goods, intermediate goods, and consumption goods. This aggregation permits external trade statistics to be considered jointly with other sets of general economic statistics such as national accounts and industrial statistics for national, regional or world level economic analysis.*
- 15.2 *The BEC includes nineteen basic categories. Each category of the BEC is defined in terms of divisions, groups, sub-groups and basic headings of HS. Each HS basic heading is allocated entirely to one BEC category. The allocation is done on the basis of the main end use of the commodities in each HS basic heading, although it is recognised that many commodities that are traded internationally may be put to a variety of uses.*
- 15.3 *The statistics in Table 16: Imports of Commodities by Broad Economic Categories Classifications are generated based on retained imports i.e. imports minus re-exports. The figure could be negative for a reference month if re-exports are higher than imports.*

16. CONFIDENTIALITY REQUIREMENTS

*The trade data statistics have been compiled under the provisions of the **Statistics Act 1965 (Revised-1989)**. The Act stipulates that the contents of individual returns are **confidential**. In conformity with the said stipulation, only aggregated figures are published.*

17. REVISION POLICY

Data for the current month is provisional and subject to revision until it is finalised. Revisions are made if there are additional information. Starting 2021, final data will be released by 7 (seven) months after reference year. Final external trade statistics for reference year 2021 was used from reference month June 2022.
