



TOP 5 TOWN WITH THE MOST POPULATION




The biggest occupied houses and population in Singapore is Chia Keng (M.XVIII) with 458 occupied houses and 3,350 persons

The state with the highest **Malay population** was Perak (710,967 people), the largest **Chinese population** was Singapore (437,243 people) while the largest **Indian population** was Perak (77,615 people).

NUMBER OF PEOPLE BORN ELSEWHERE IN MALAYA BUT ENUMERATED IN THE TERRITORY




▲ Malay ▲ Locally – Born Chinese

State of Kedah recorded the highest number of people born elsewhere in Malaya enumerated in the territory with 20,997 peoples.




AGE DISTRIBUTION: FEDERATION OF MALAYA (Year 1947)



The population aged 0 - 9 years was the largest age group in the Federation of Malaya with a distribution of 261 males and 291 females per 1,000 people. Meanwhile, the population aged 55 and above is the lowest population.

The population distribution patterns for the three races in the Federation of Malaya are the same. The only difference was observed in ethnic Chinese with the age group of 20 - 29 years where only 115 men and 137 women as compared to Malay and Indian.
